- **Banner Oversight Committee (BOC)**

- **MyMU/MILO**
  - Computing Services completed the in-house fix for the single sign on problem between myMU and MILO.
- **Human Resources/Finance**

- **Oracle Release**
  - Myke Watts announced that a new Oracle patch is available and he is currently trying to find a date when he can install it.
  - Oracle is discontinuing 10g support, but Sungard does not currently support Oracle 11g for Banner. As soon as support notice is received from Sungard, the University will move to 11g, tentatively in the Fall.
- **Faculty Information/Digital Measures**
  - Barbara Hicks completed the faculty data entry. The data was extracted and sent to Digital Measures. Pat Gebhart is reviewing the reporting.
- **Document Management Suite**
  - Admissions is trying to determine how to incorporate this into their current business processes before testing begins. Financial Aid is awaiting their scanner before they can start testing.
- **Faculty Advisor/myMU hold**
  - No report.
- **SSN Masking**
  - There is currently no start date set for this project
- **New PIN proposal**
  - Arnold Miller stated that this may be solved with the Banner Enrollment Management Suite that IT is currently implementing.
- **CIPC Code Table Update**
  - David and Ben are currently preparing to put this in Preproduction and will be working with Michael McGuffey and the Registrar's Office to test it before moving it into Production. Pat Gebhart asked if Financial Aid should be included in the testing, but Cheri and Nadine indicated that they did not feel it was necessary

- **Banner Enrollment Management Suite**
  - Arnold Miller expressed thanks to everyone for their patience. This should be installed in Preproduction this week. Brent showed the group what it will look like upon implementation. This product has the Banner "new look" that Sungard is moving to with all of its products.
- **Grade Roll**
  - Pat and Myke worked on this but haven't yet been able to resolve the issue. There is a possibility that they may end up modifying the code to get this problem corrected.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

- **Self-Service Demonstration**
  - Brent Maynard showed the group what the new self-service myMU will look like.

- The icons will be a little different but serve the same purpose.
- The University is beginning to implement Banner channels into the portal so that Banner information is accessible without logging into MILO. Students, faculty and staff can customize much of their channel content but some of the content will be static for all users. The channels that will remain static are yet to be determined.
- New MILO front page and navigation. Employee (leave balances, etc.) and Finance Self Service (budget transfers, approvals, etc.) options
