## SOPHOMORE IN HIGH SCHOOL AND BELOW (UZ91)

- ☐ An ACT / SAT at the 85th percentile or above (ACT Composite Score = 26, SAT = 1170 CR+M). If the ACT or SAT has not been taken, a score at the 90th percentile or higher on another nationally-normed standardized test, such as the PLAN or EXPLORE, that provides evidence of the ability to succeed at the college level.
- ☐ High school transcript reflecting a cumulative minimum GPA of 3.00 on 4.00 scale
