



TAILGATE AT WVU GAME WITH THE HERD, OCT. 17

We've got a new spot in Morgantown within walking distance (some of it uphill) to Mountaineer Field. We've rented a big parking lot next to the Grand Central Business Center at the top of 6th Street hill. We can park approximately 140 vehicles at \$10 a space, plus the \$25 per person tailgate charge.

- *Here's the directions if you're going north on I-79.*
- *Take Exit 155 and go right on US-19/WV-7.*
- *Stay on 19/7 for approximately 2.5 miles.*
- *Turn left, at 6th Street and go up the hill until you get just past Beverly Ave., and on the left you will come to Grand Central Business Center.*
- *Enter the parking lot at its first (lower) entrance and you will be directed to a space on the upper parking lot where the Big Green tailgate is located.*

When you make your reservations for the tailgate you will be asked to purchase one parking space for \$10 and a \$25 tailgate ticket for each person in your vehicle.
