Visual Art Majors must receive a "C" or better in ART courses to satisfy the requirements. Students seeking a substitution for required coursework must have advisor and Director approval prior to enrollment in the class. With approval of the Director, credit transferred from another institution as ART 1XX or ART2XX may be used to fulfill required ART coursework numbered from 1XX to 4XX. Such transferred credit, however, does not build toward the CAM requirement to complete at least 40 hours of 300/400 level coursework.

Senior evaluation is required at 90 credit hours; apply for graduation for final audit in Fall of senior year for Spring graduation; and in Spring of senior year for Fall graduation.
