Such transferred credit, however, does not build toward the CAM requirement to complete at least 40 hours of 300/400 level coursework.

Senior evaluation is required at 90 credit hours; apply for graduation for final audit in Fall of senior year for Spring graduation; and in Spring of senior year for Fall graduation.
