

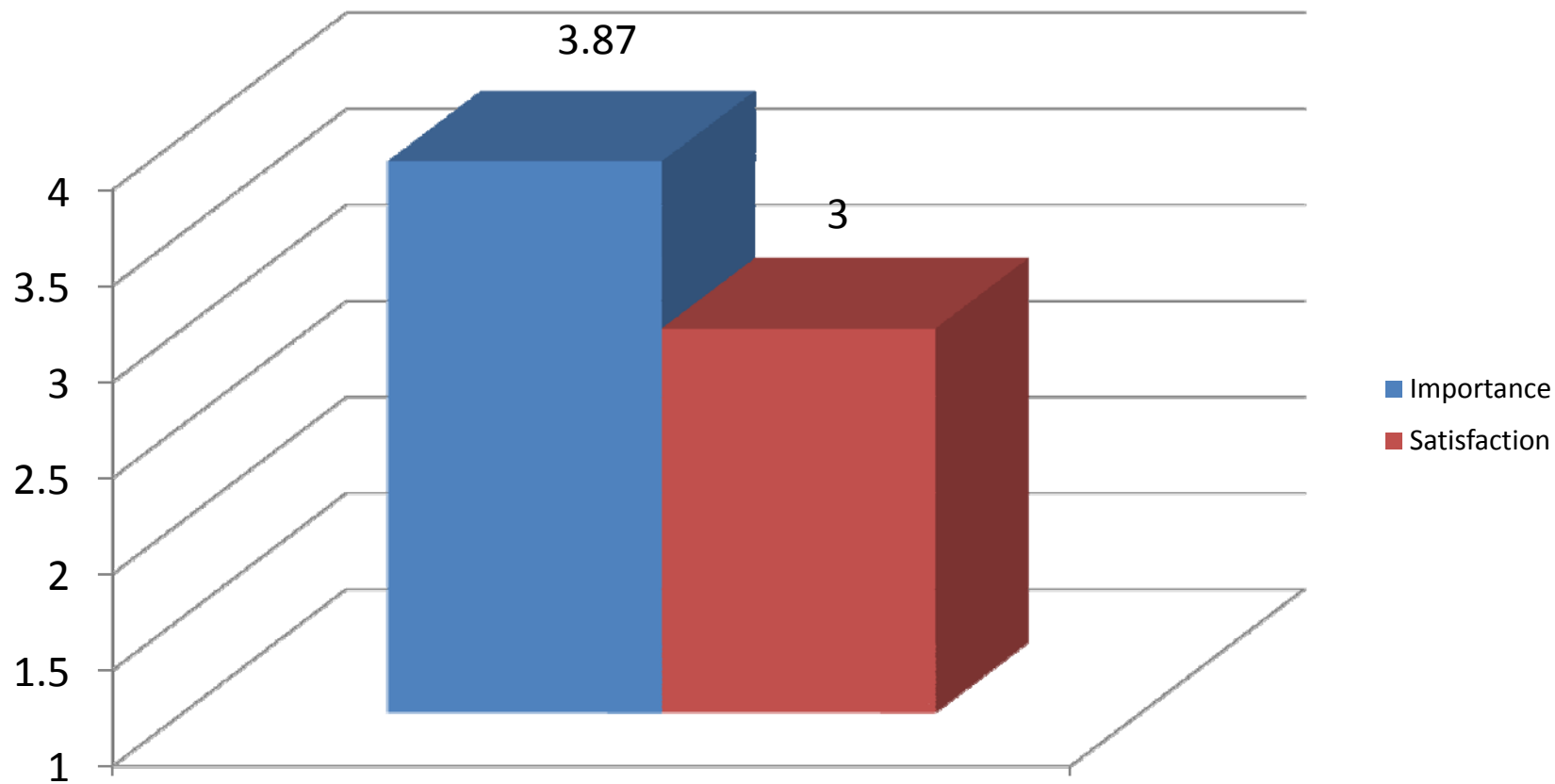

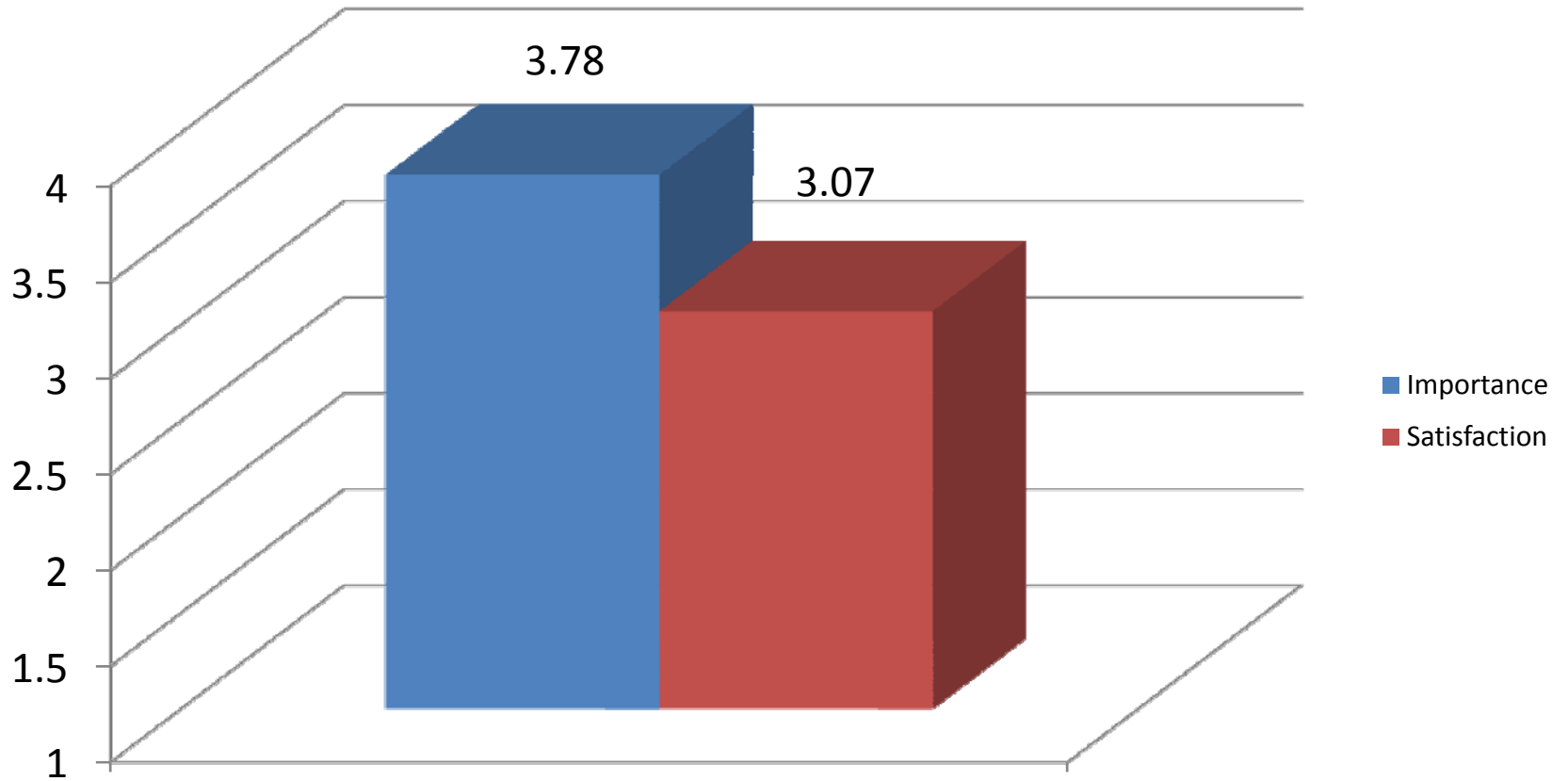
Mean Comparisons for Importance and Satisfaction

Scale = 1 (Not important/Not satisfied) to 4 (Very important/Very Satisfied)

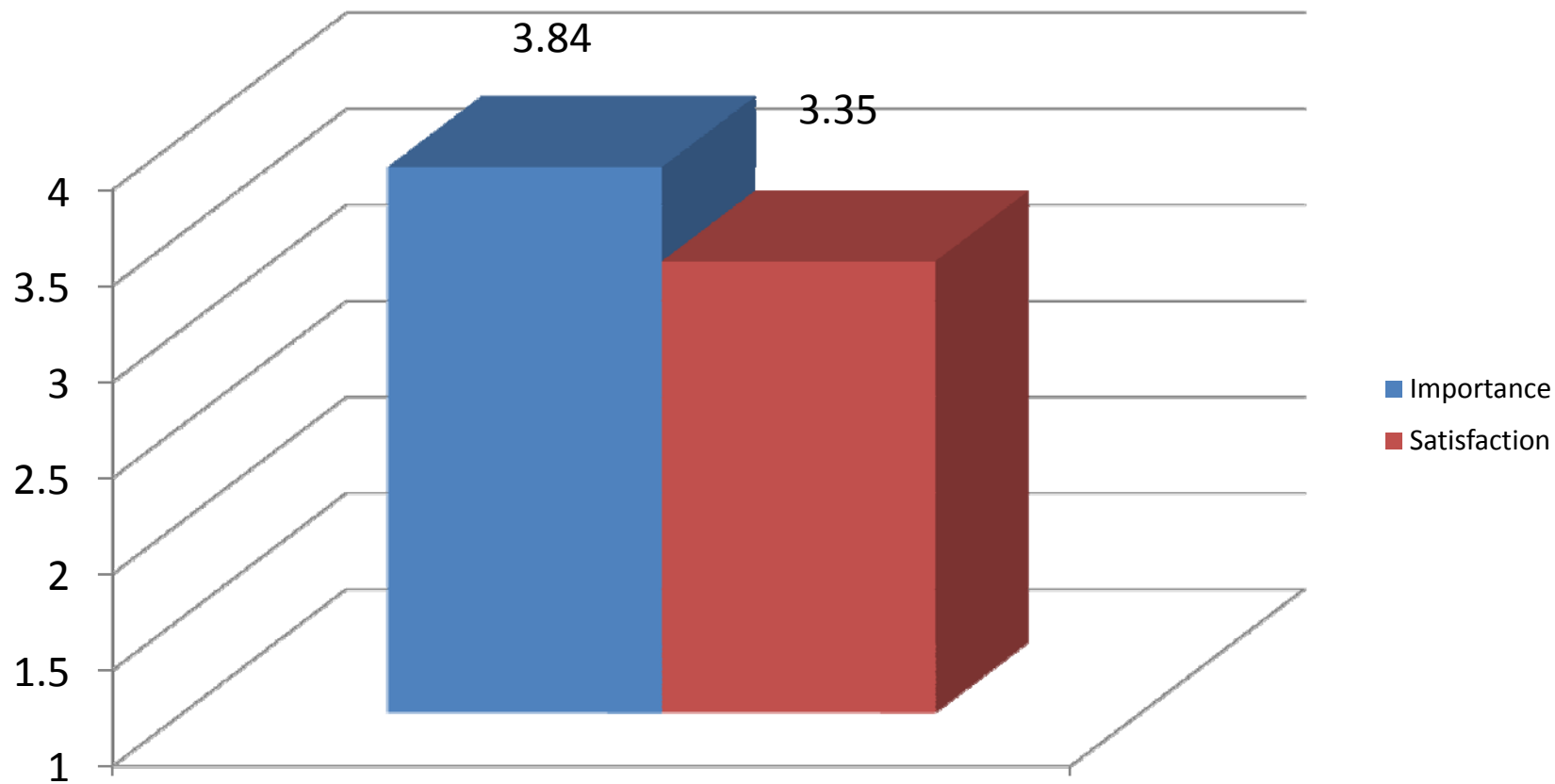
Question 1: Curriculum prepared me to meet career demands: $n = 68$ (I) and 72 (S)



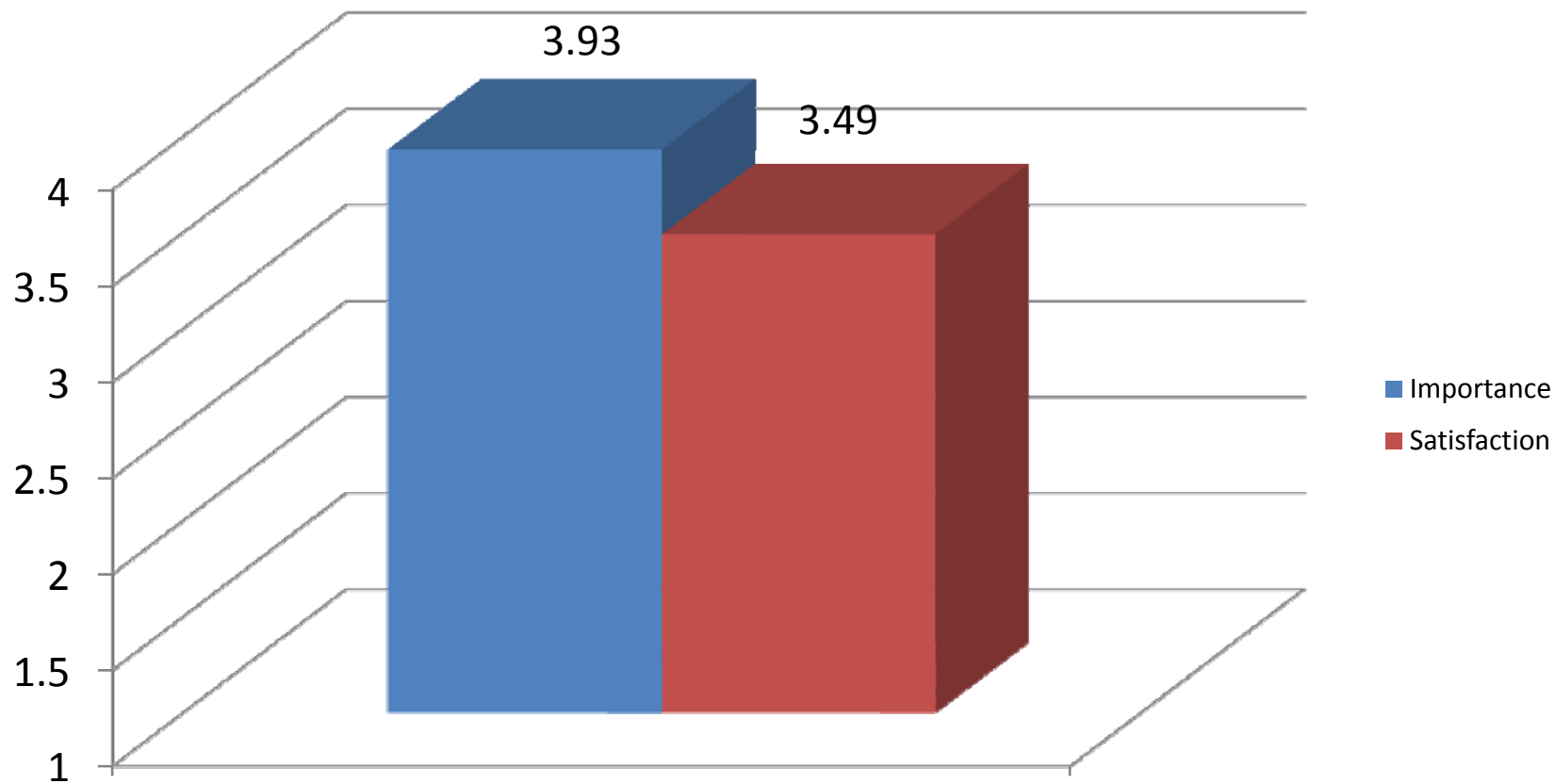
Question 2: Curriculum had a logical learning sequence: $n = 68$ (I) and 74 (S)



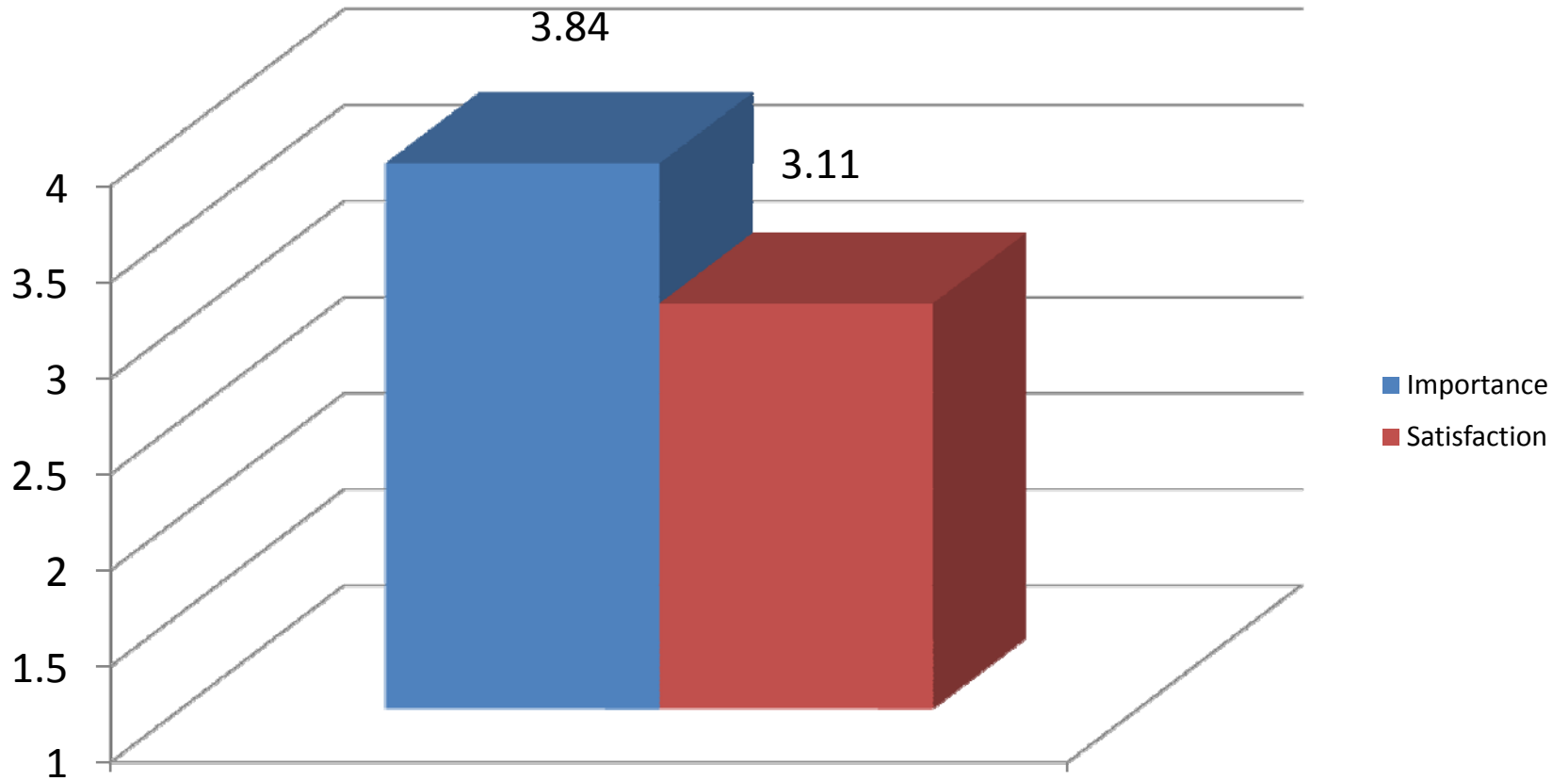
Question 3: Availability of faculty for advising and counseling: $n = 68$ (I) and 74 (S)



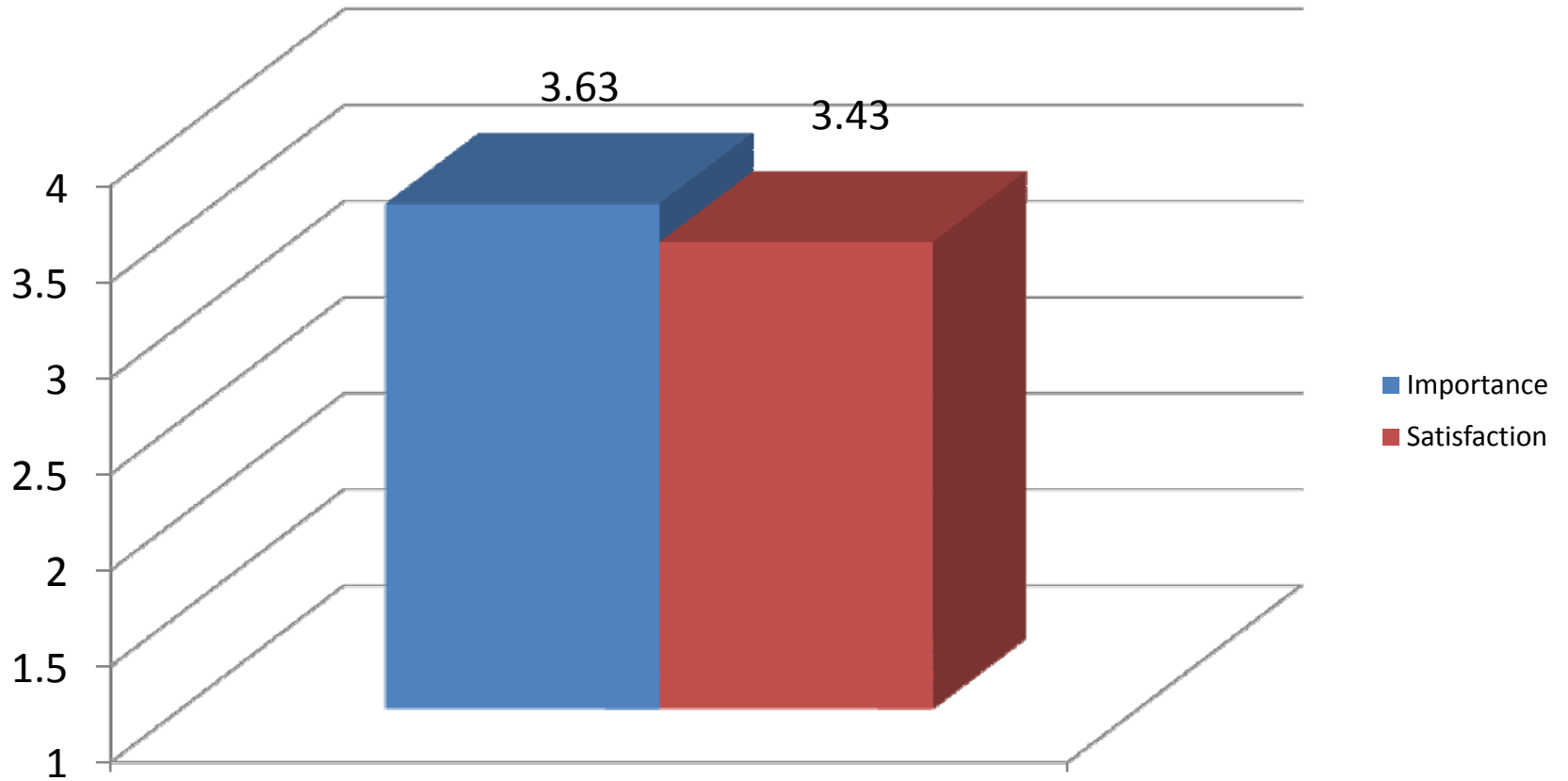
Question 4: Faculty were helpful to me in my pursuit of education: $n = 68$ (I) and 72 (S)



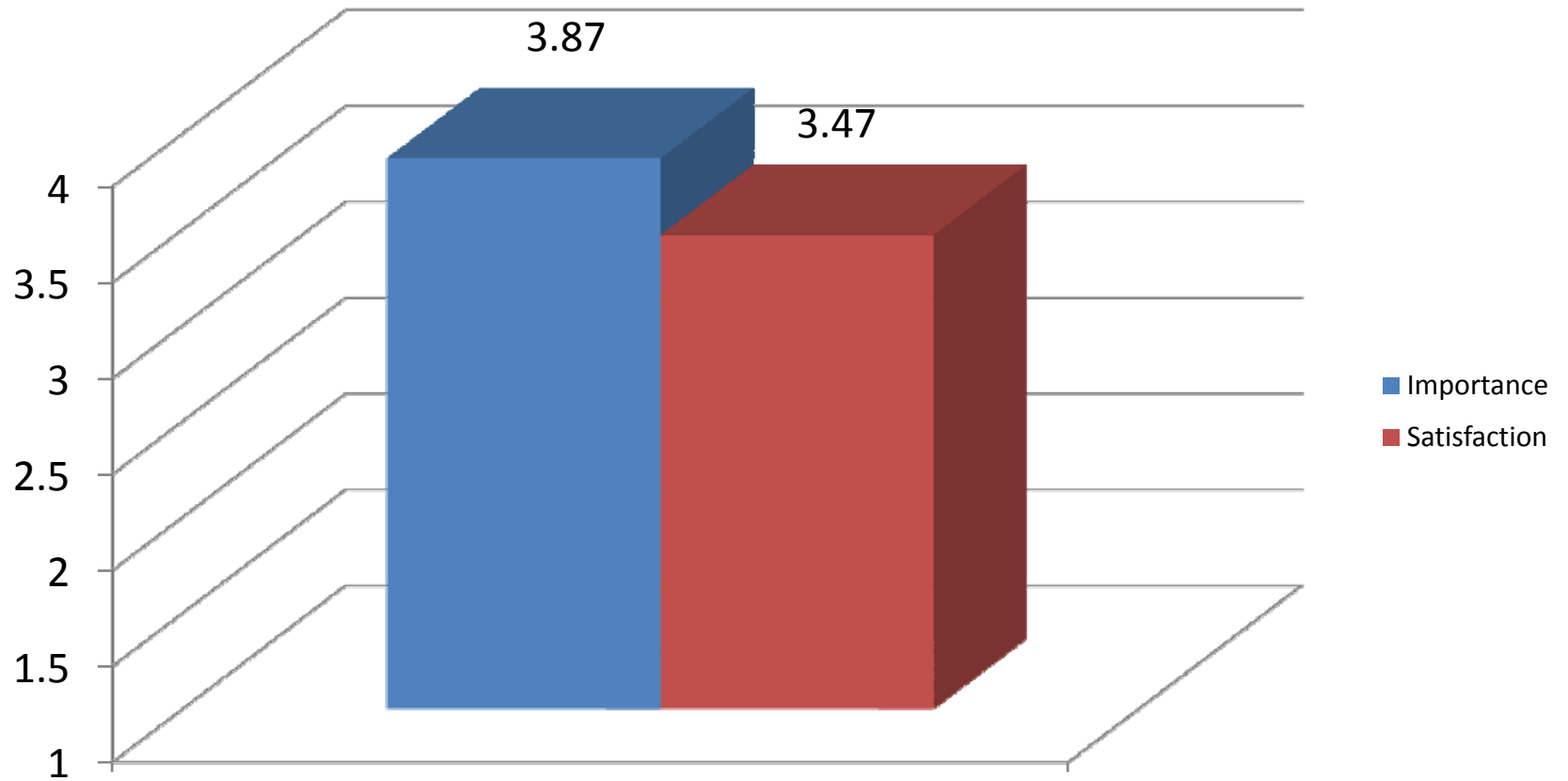
Question 5: Faculty and staff were helpful in career planning: $n = 68$ (I) and 72 (S)



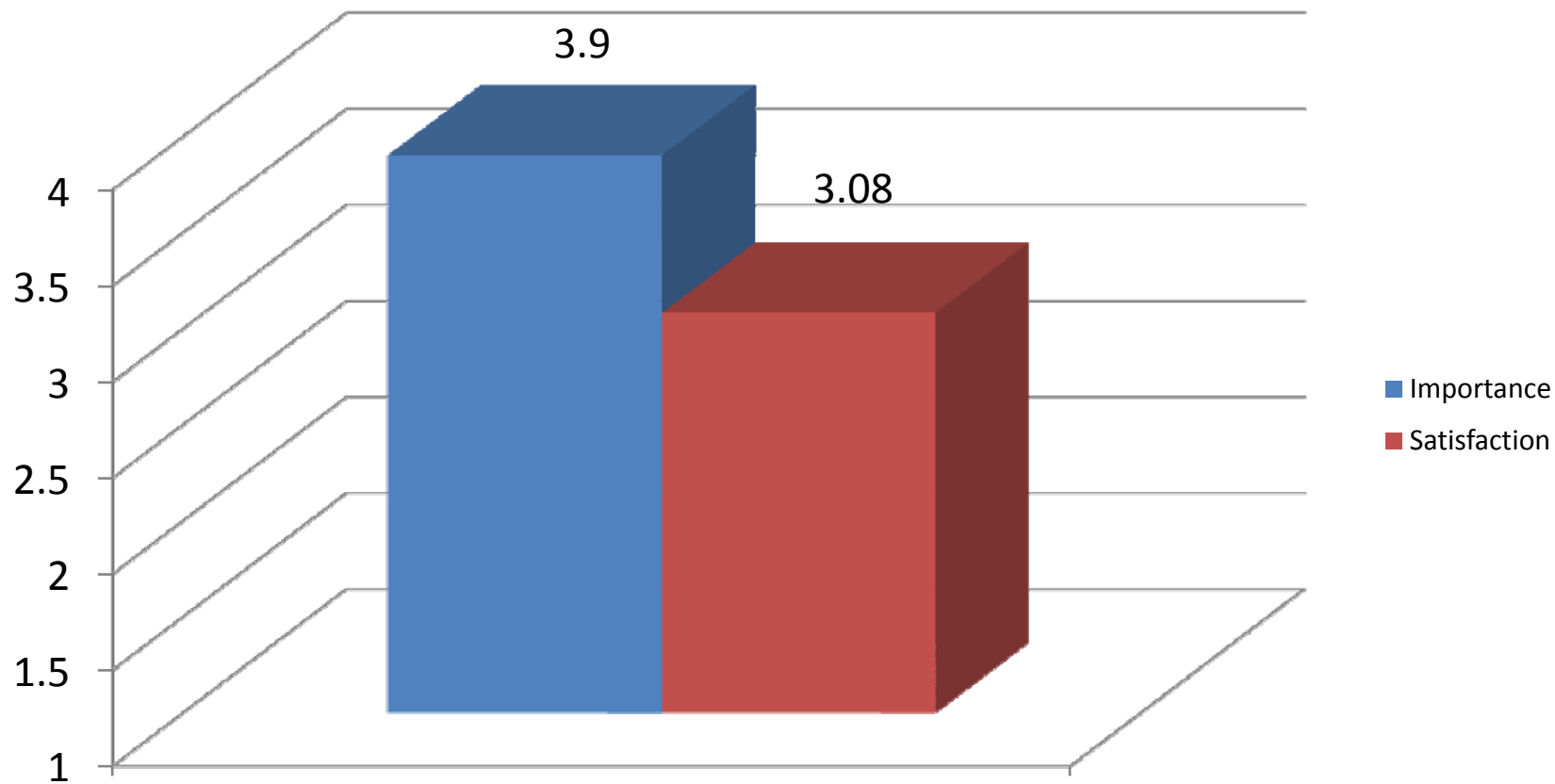
Question 6: Student participation in collegiate and departmental activities was encouraged: $n = 68$ (I) and 72 (S)



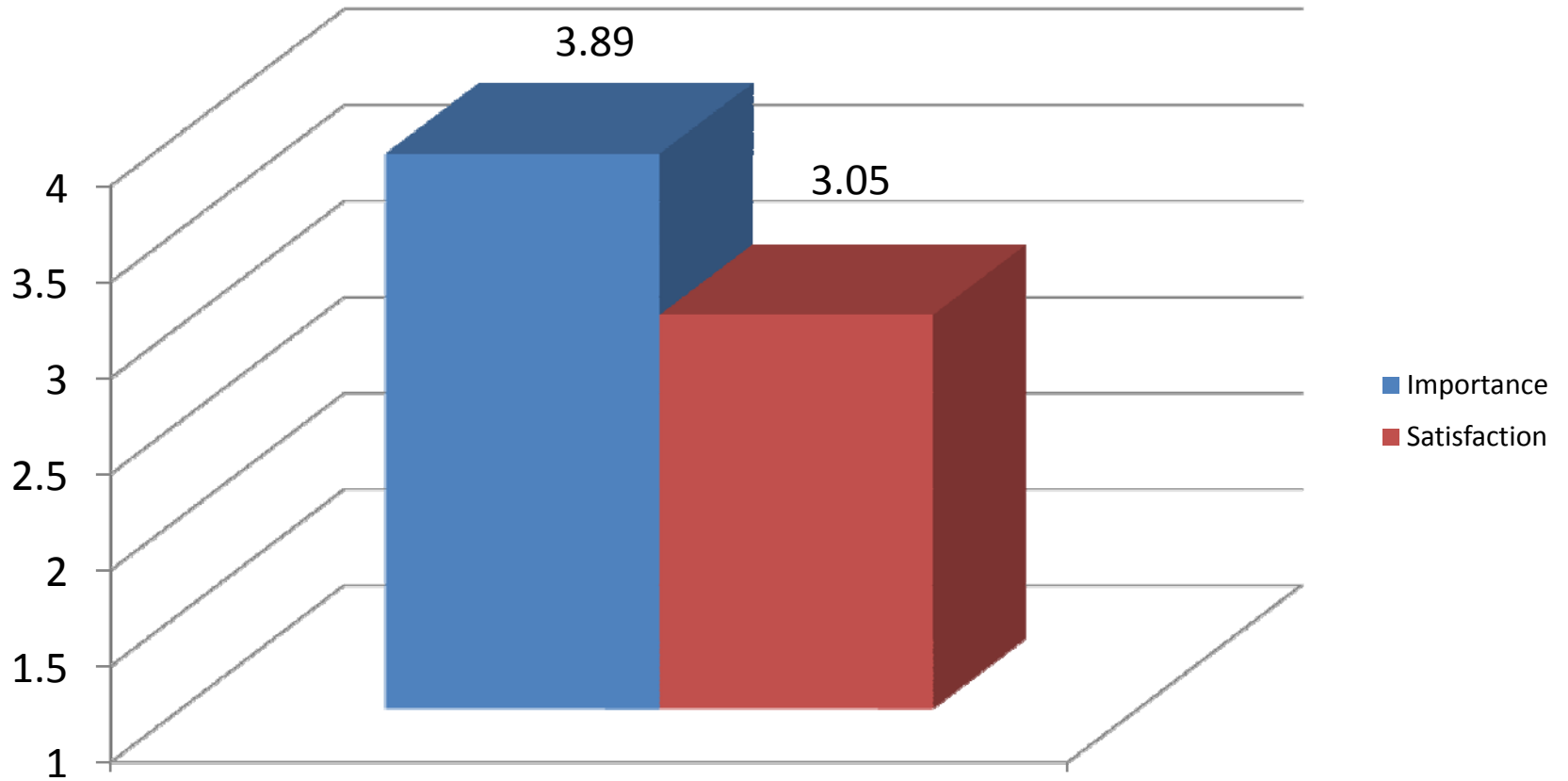
Question 7: Program improved my skills: $n = 68$ (I) and 73 (S)



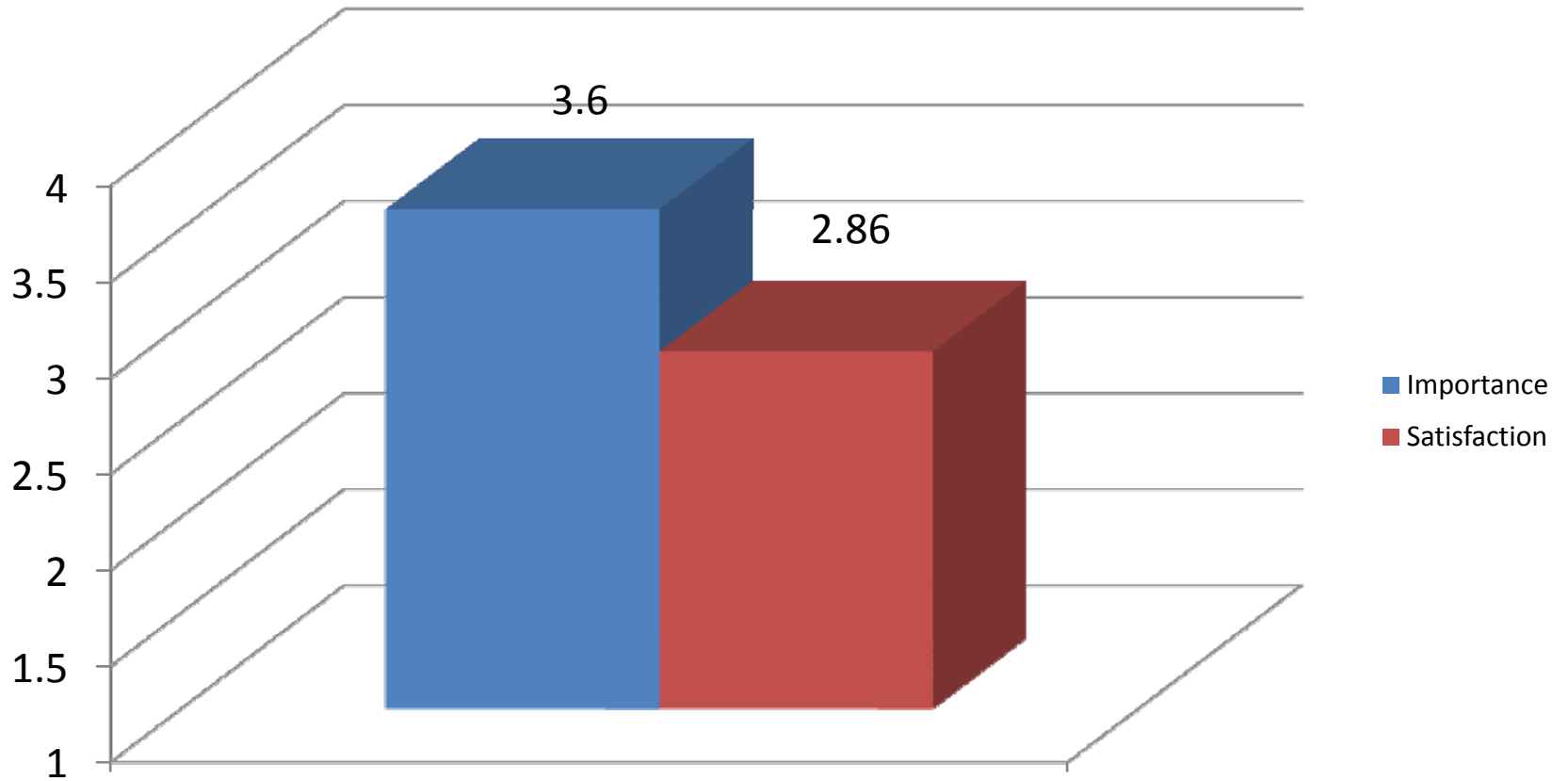
Question 8: Educational facilities were appropriate: $n = 68$ (I) and 74 (S)



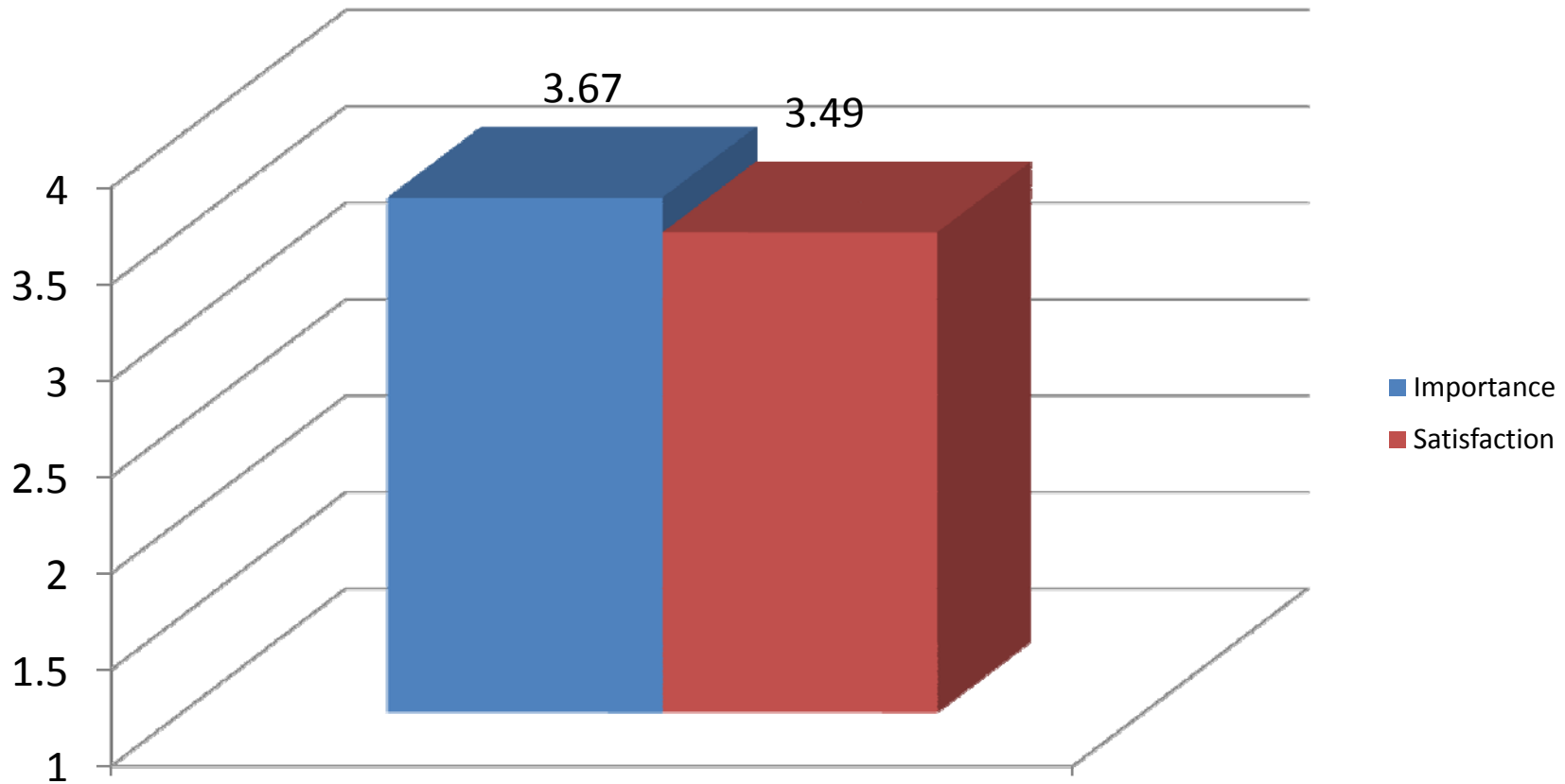
Question 9: Educational equipment was appropriate: $n = 66$ (I) and 73 (S)



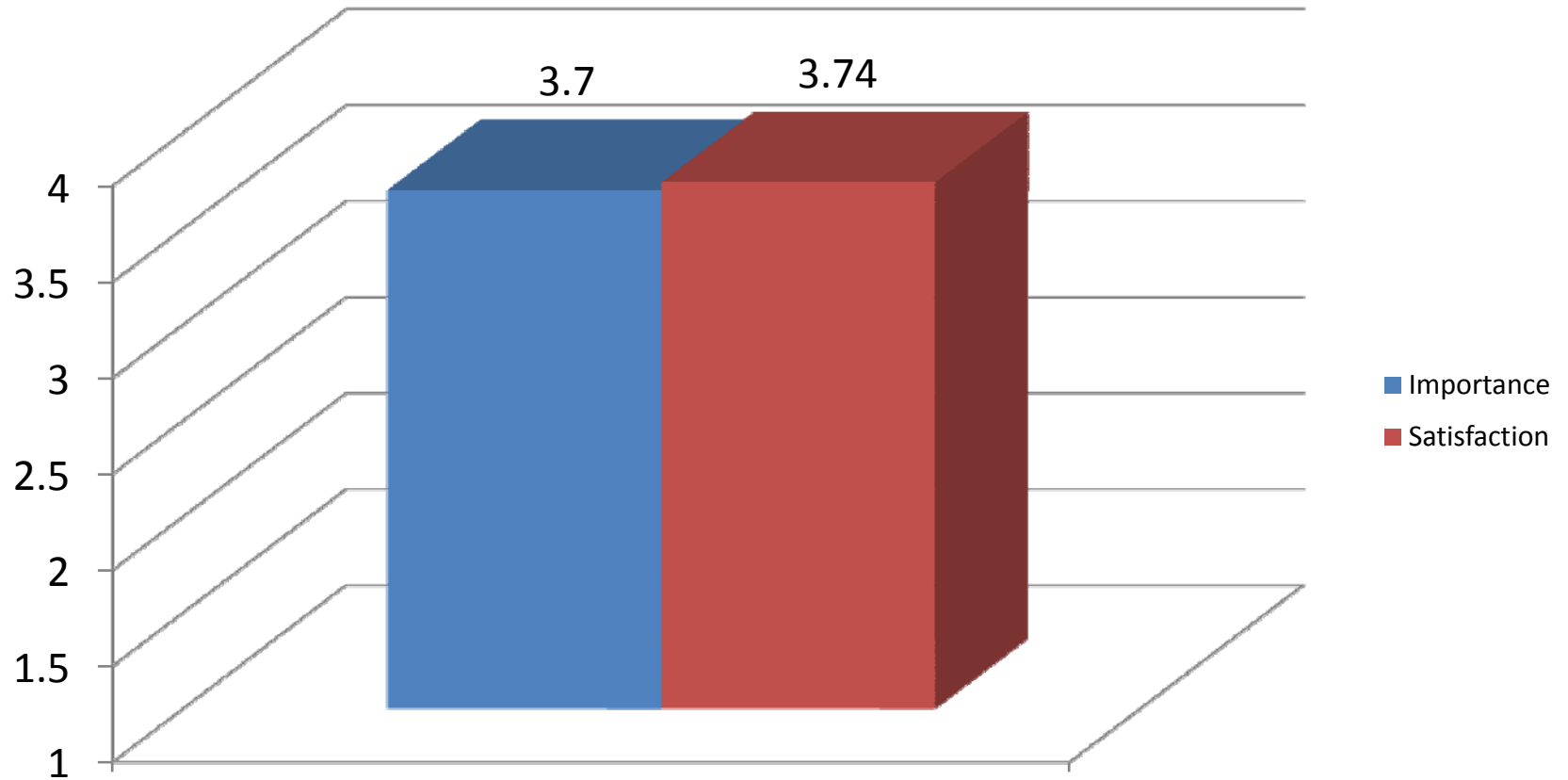
Question 10: General studies requirements were appropriate: $n = 67$ (I) and 73 (S)



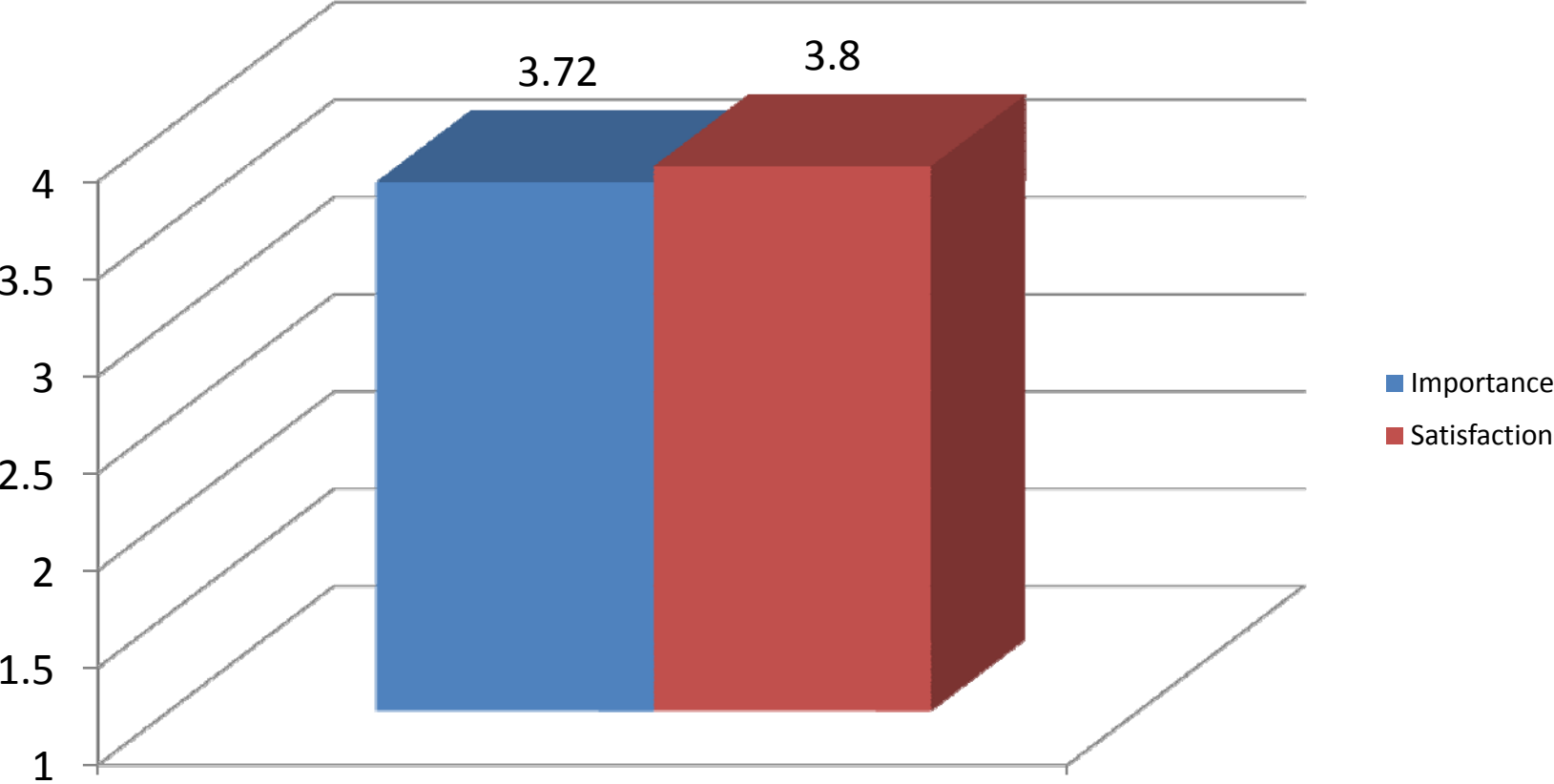
Question 11: Dean's office was helpful: $n = 67$ (I) and 71 (S)



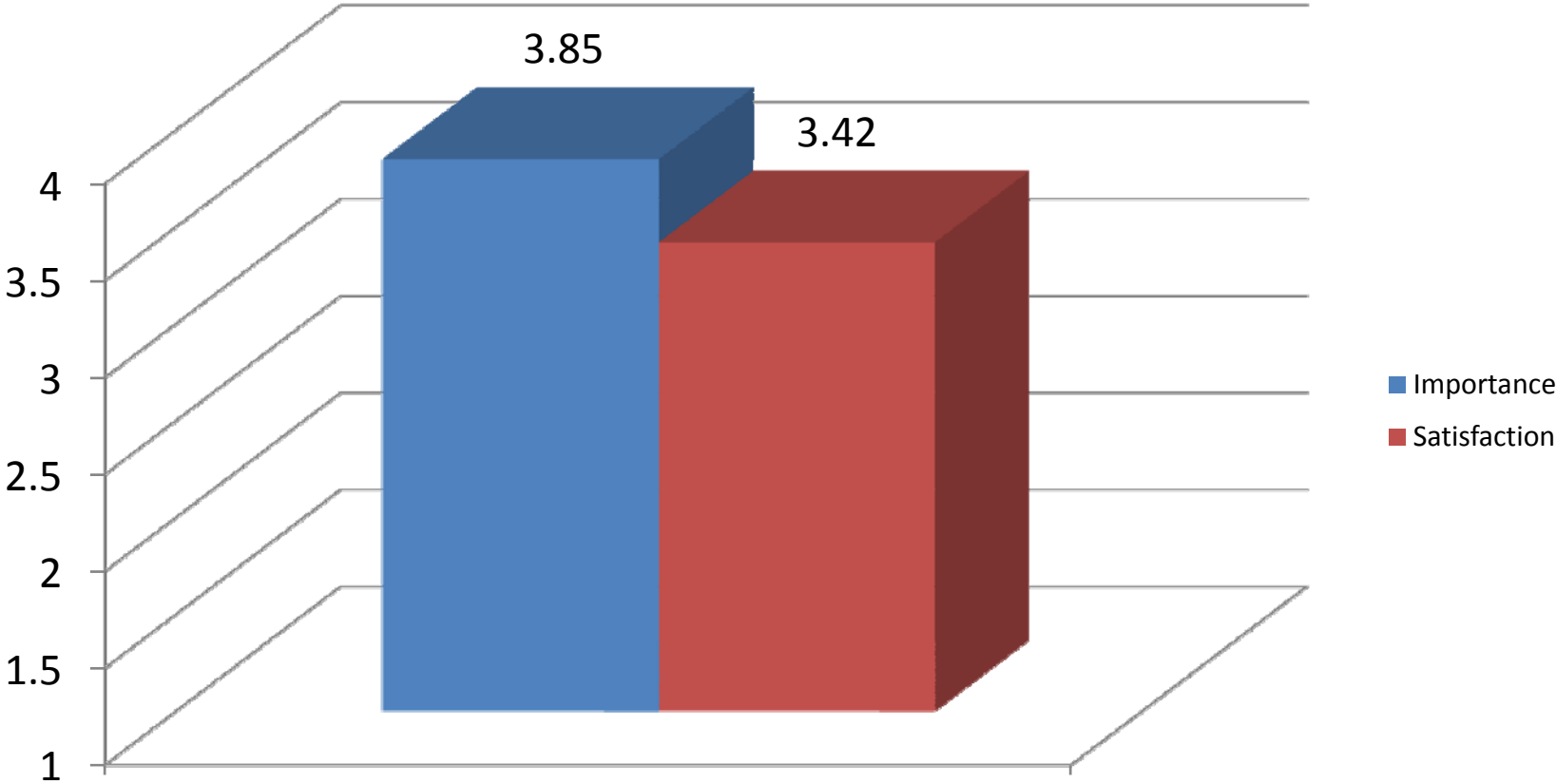
Question 12: College and Department were equally supportive of women and men: $n = 66$ (I) and 70 (S)
