

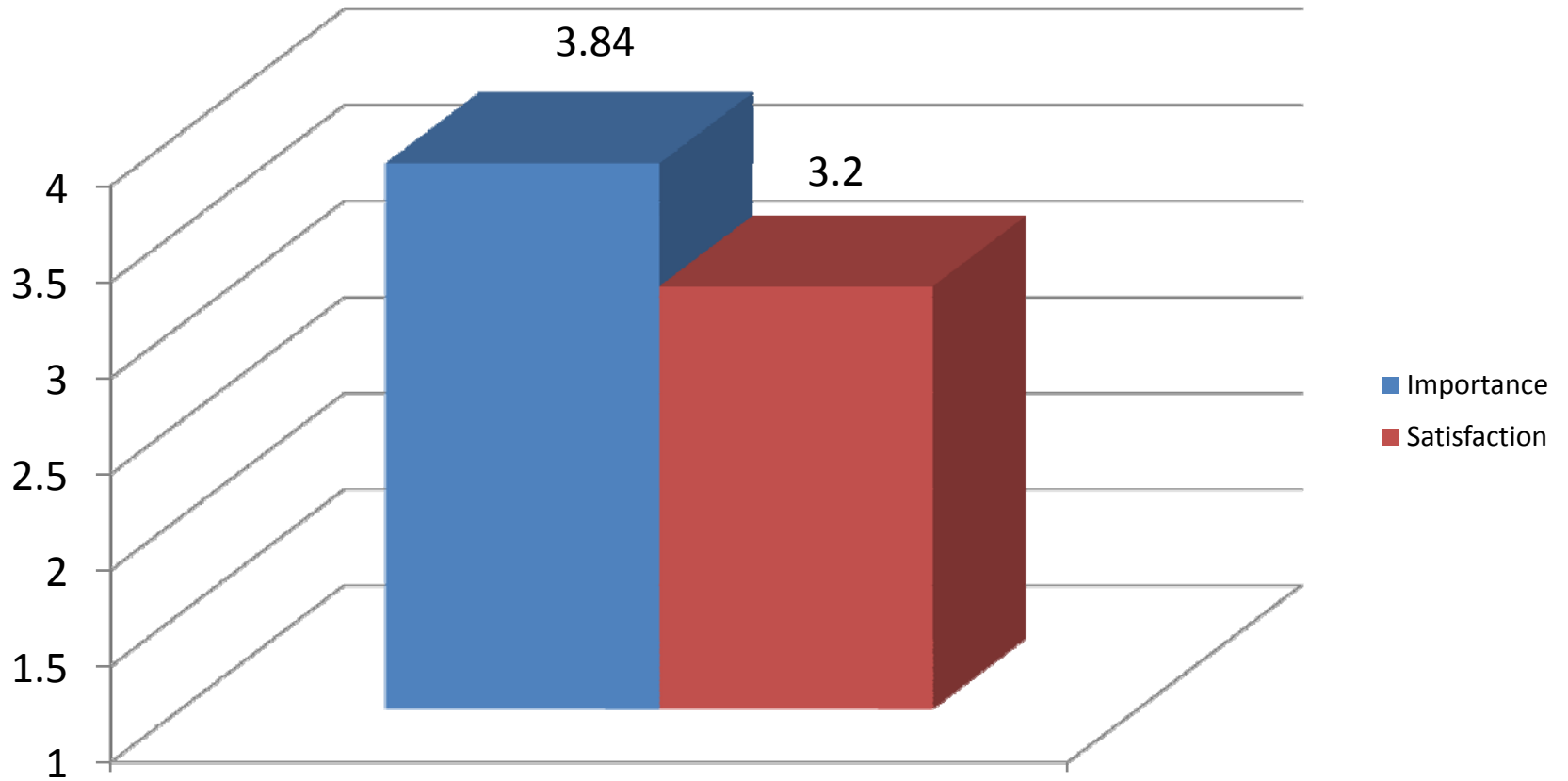

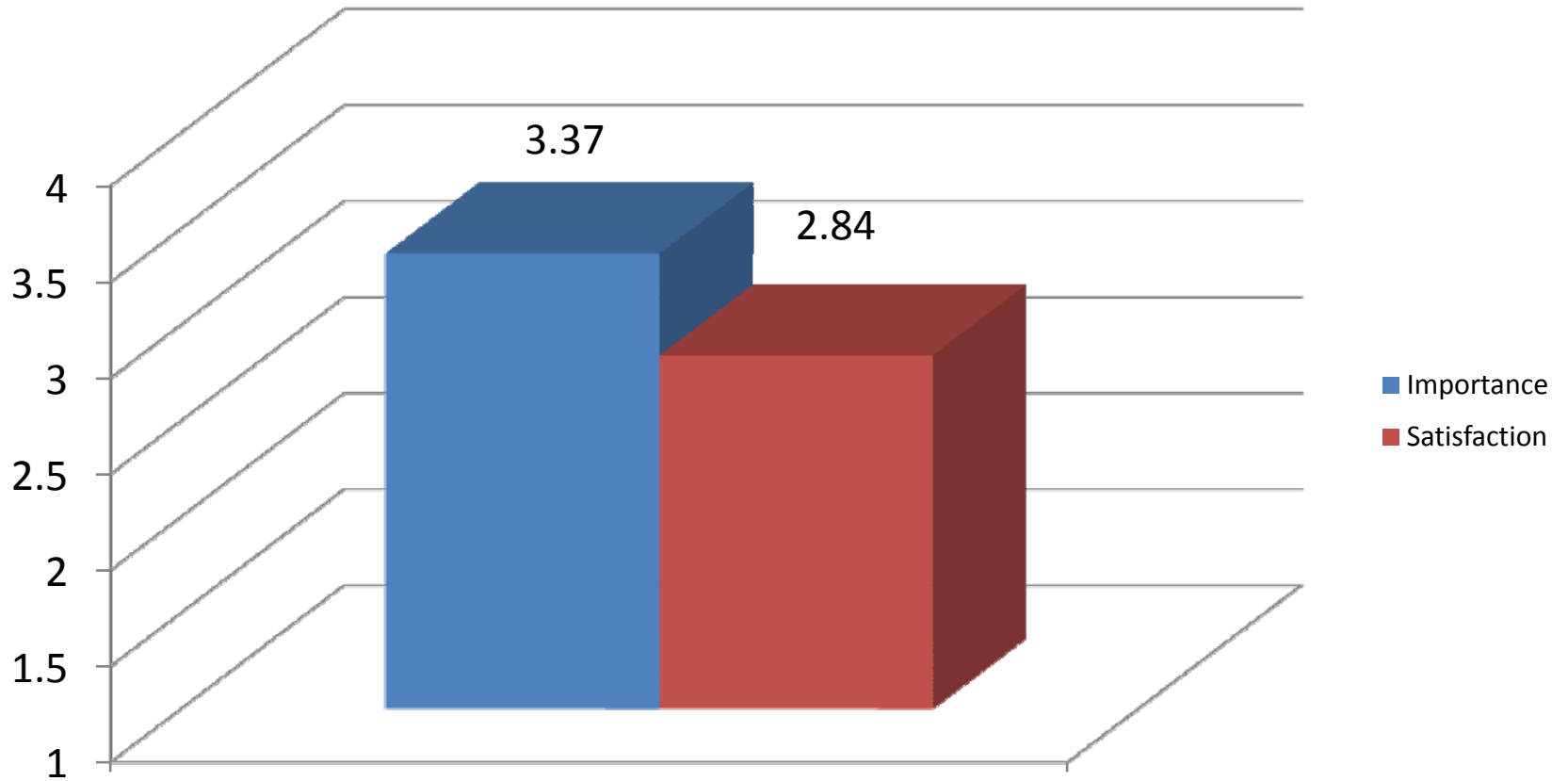
Mean Comparisons for Importance and Satisfaction

Scale = 1 (Not important/Not satisfied) to 4 (Very important/Very Satisfied)

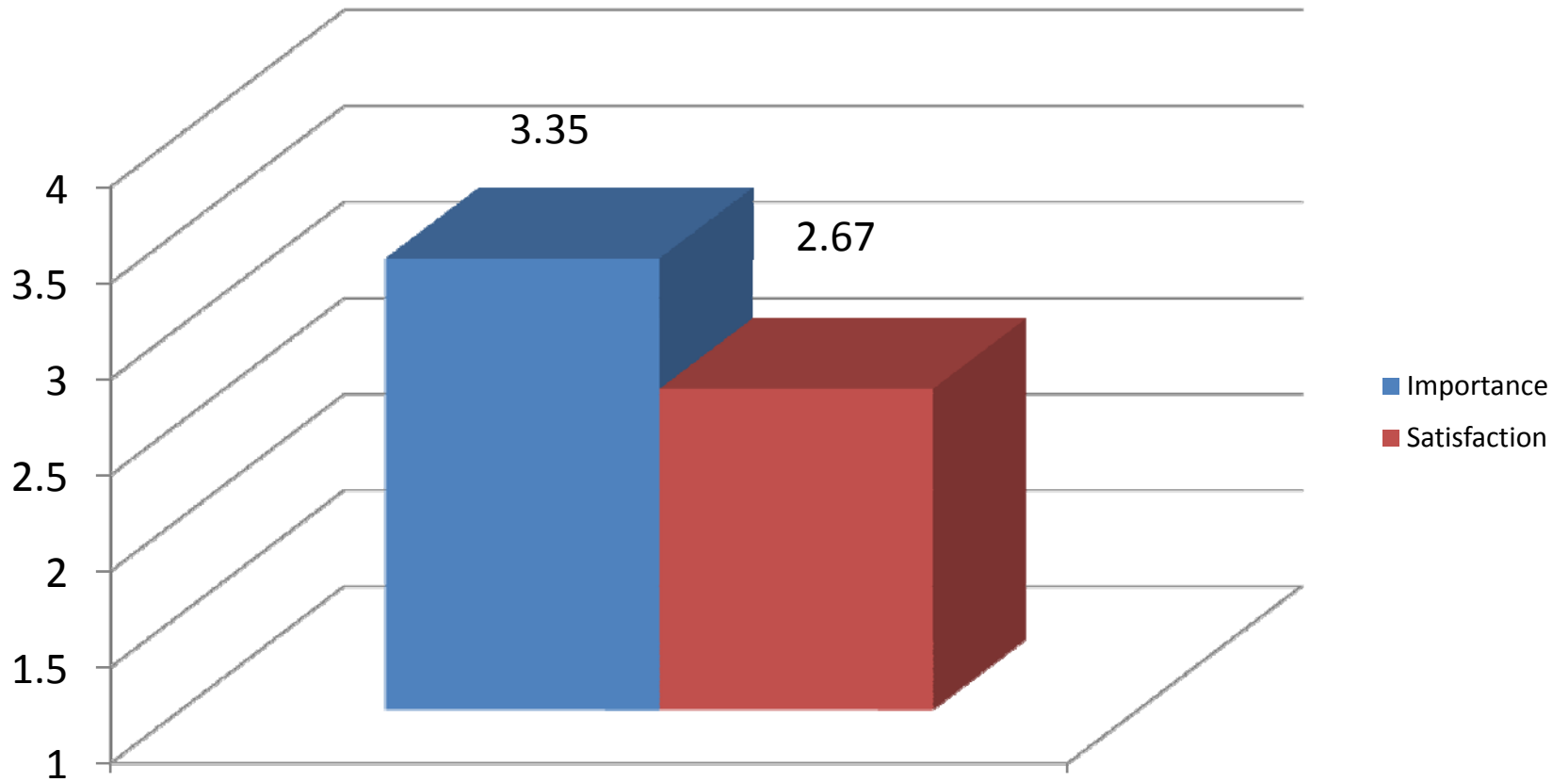
Question 1: Accounting courses promote critical thinking and analytic skills: $n = 63$ (I) and 65 (S)



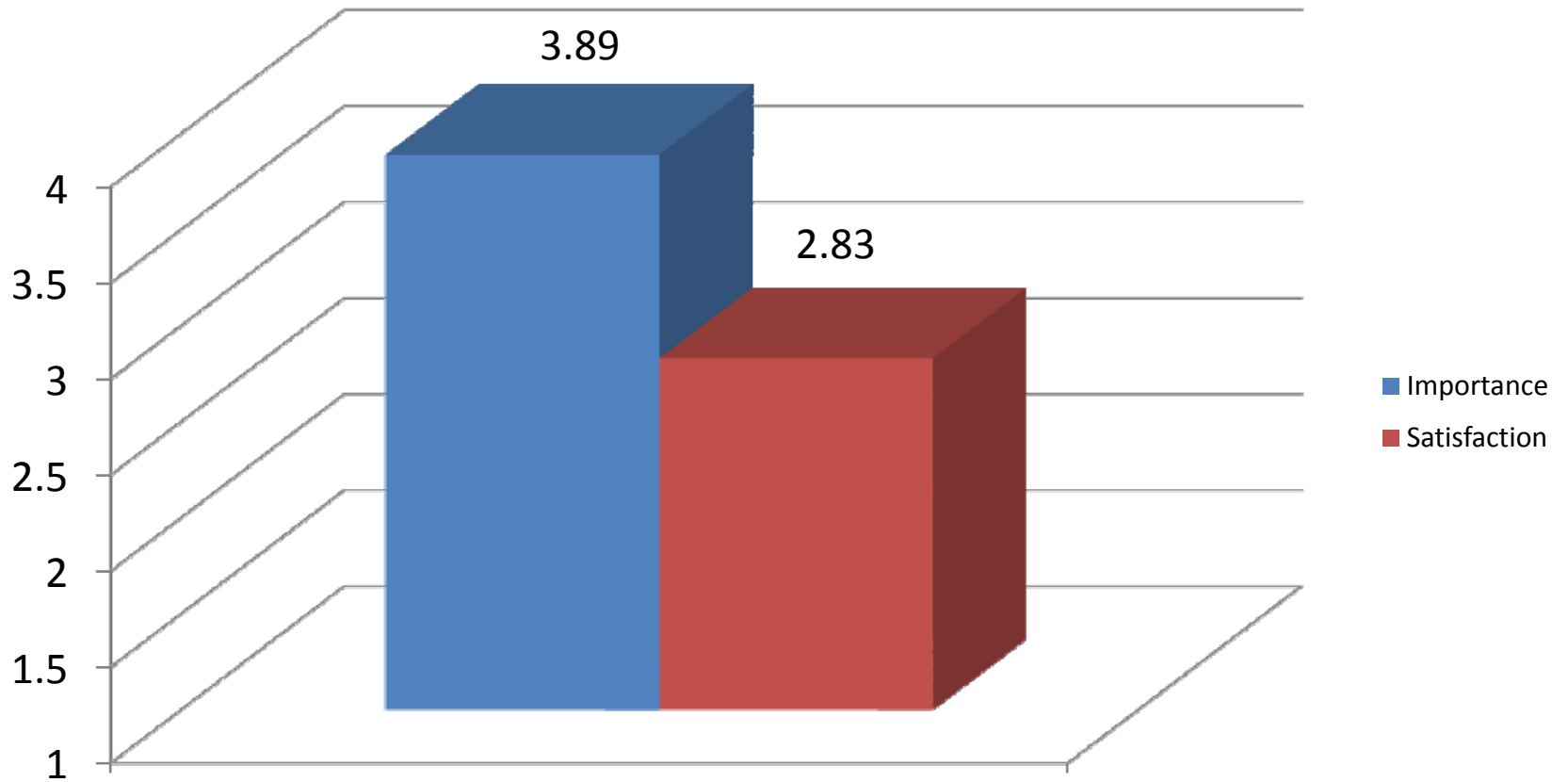
Question 2: Accounting courses promote writing skills: $n = 63$ (I) and 64 (S)



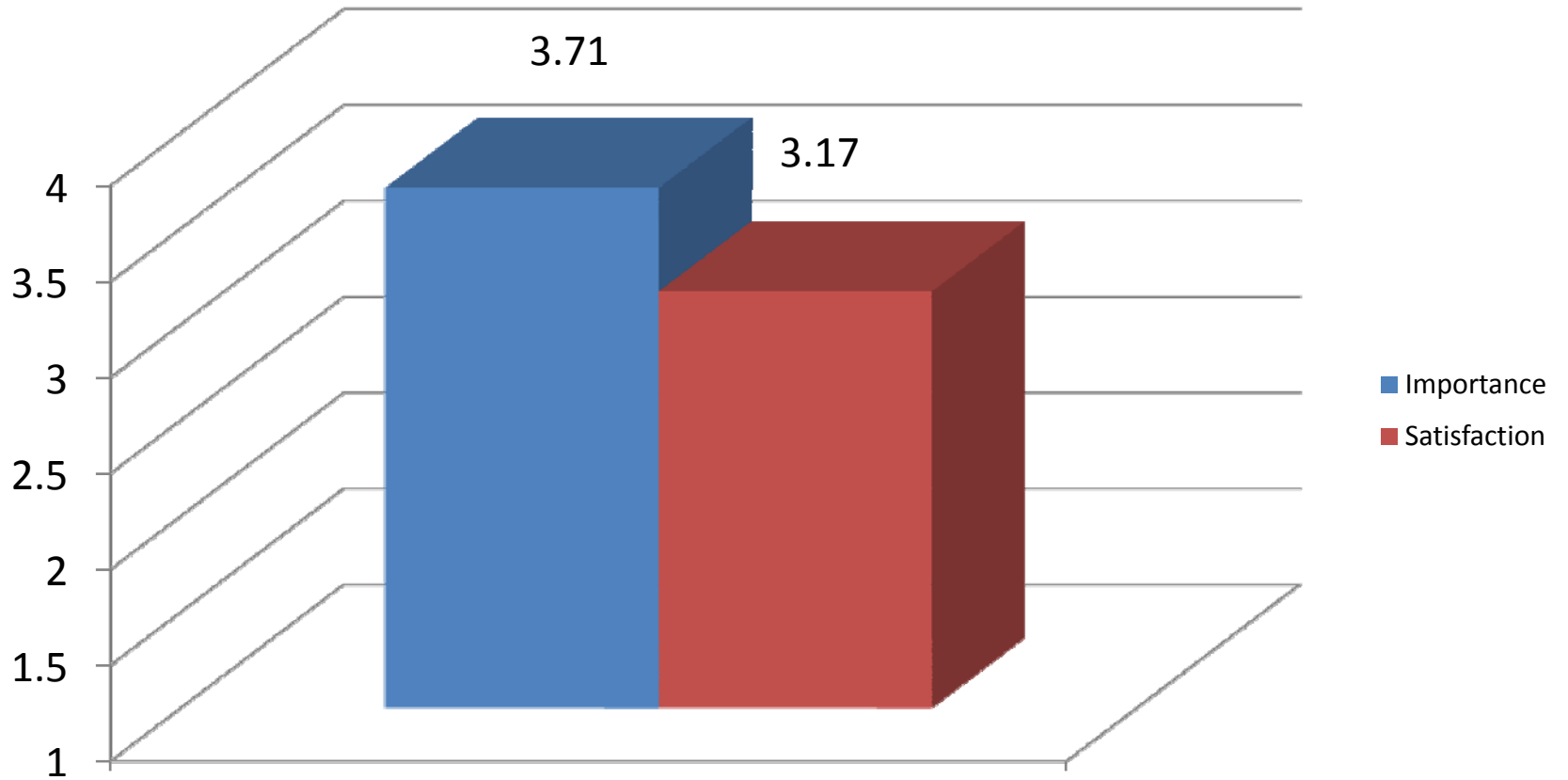
Question 3: Accounting courses promote speaking skills: $n = 63$ (I) and 64 (S)



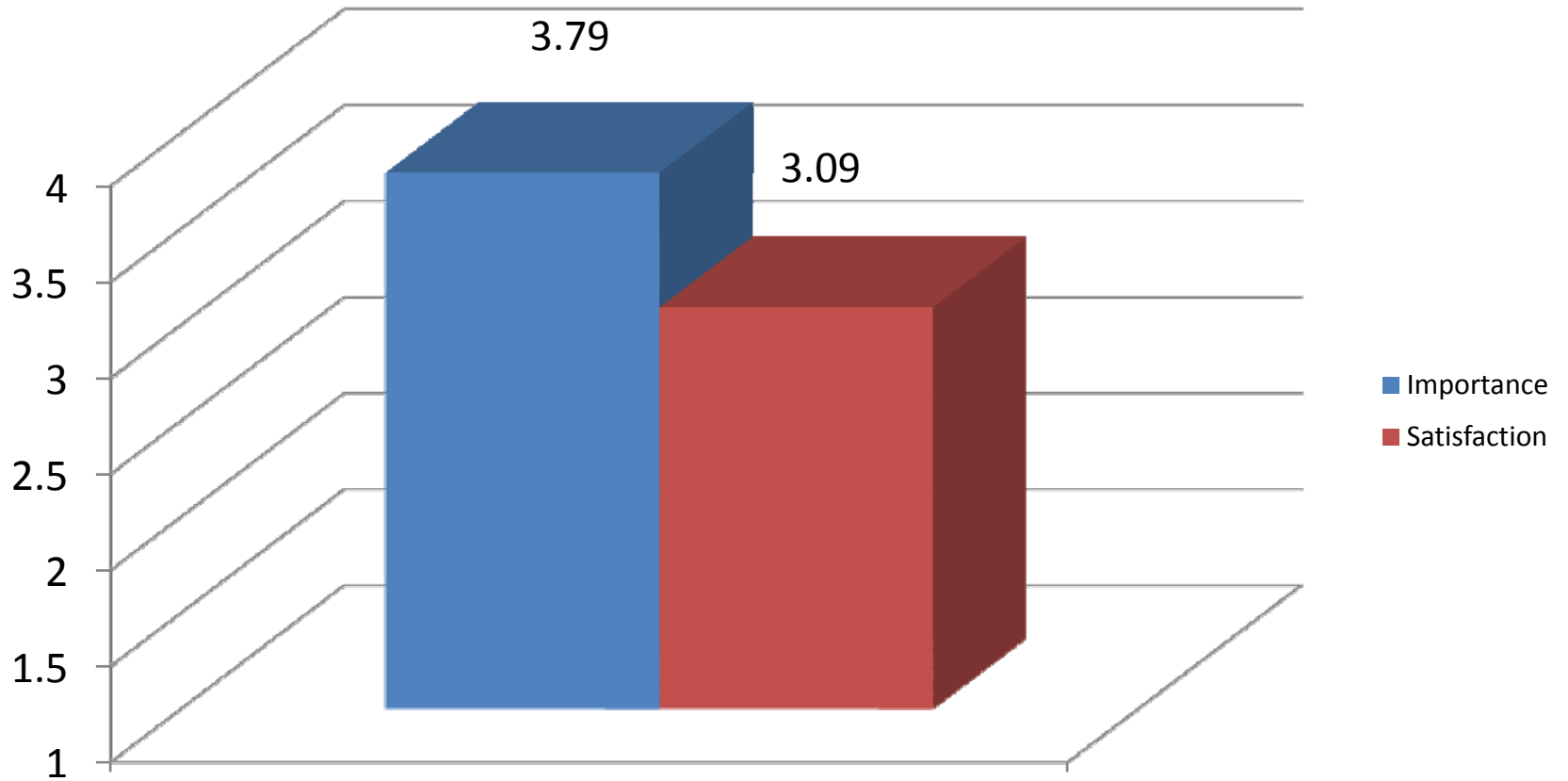
Question 4: Accounting courses adequately prepared me for my planned career: $n = 62$ (I) and 65 (S)
