

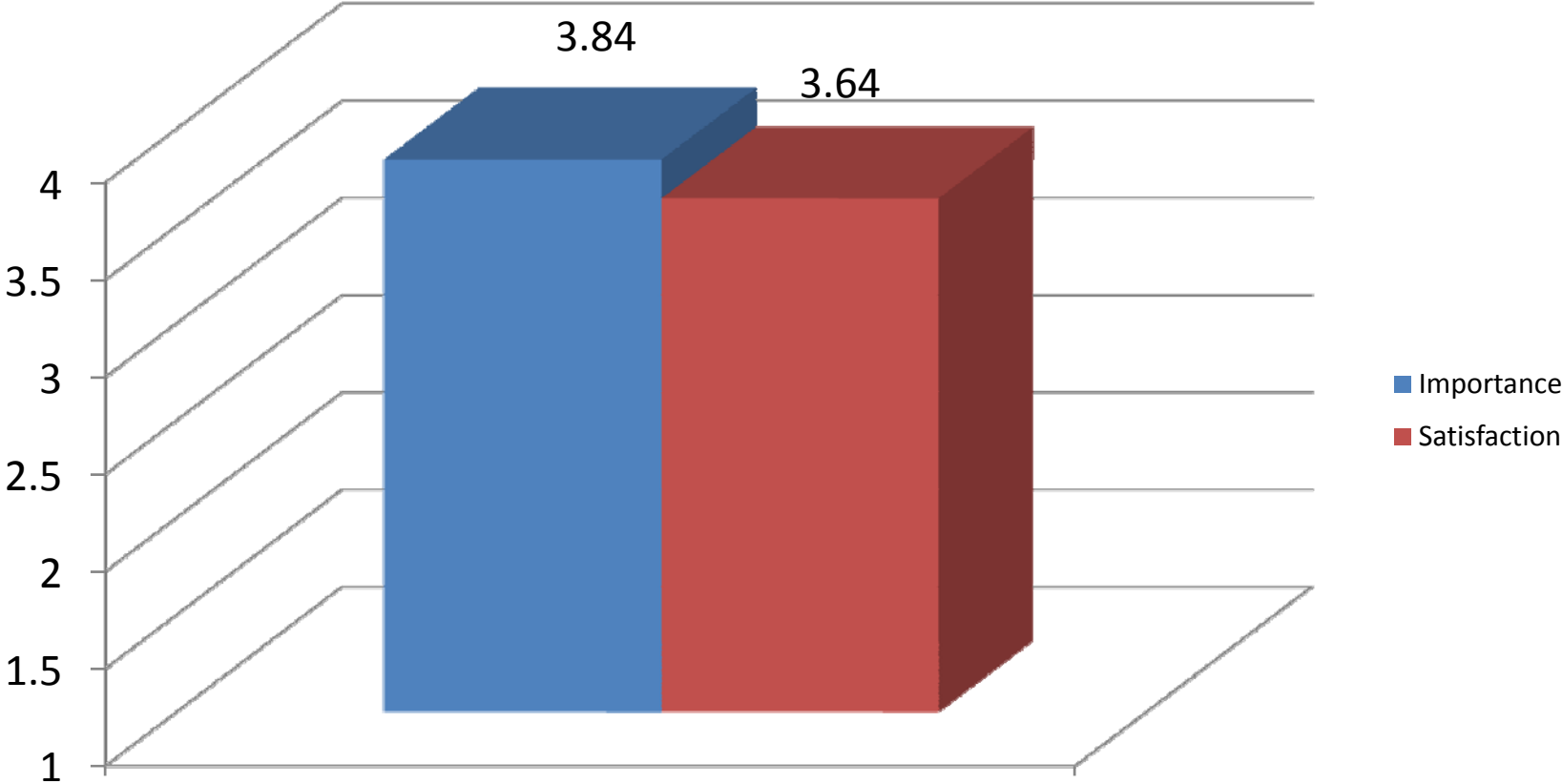

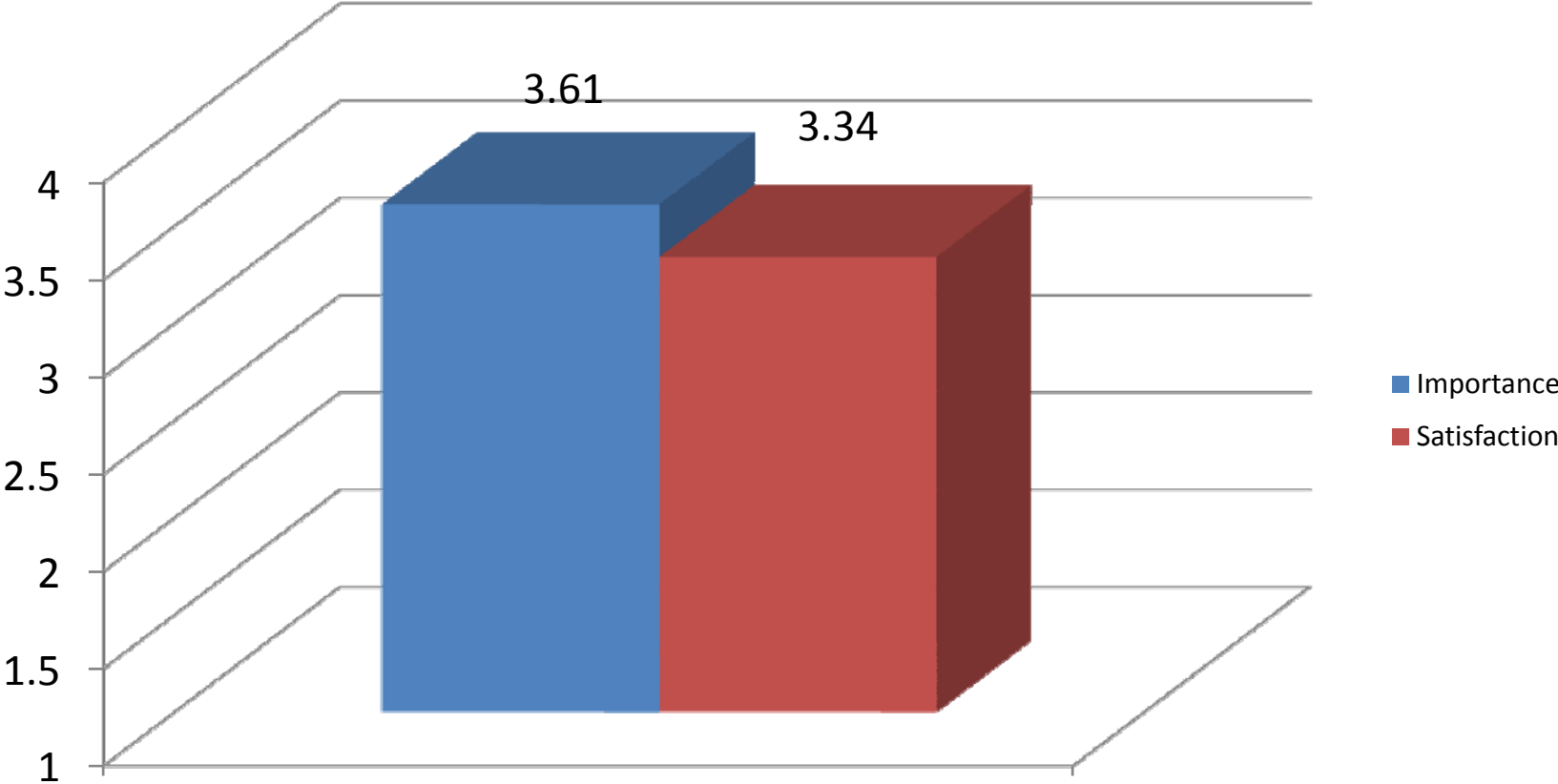
# Mean Comparisons for Importance and Satisfaction

Scale = 1 (Not important/Not satisfied) to 4 (Very important/Very Satisfied)

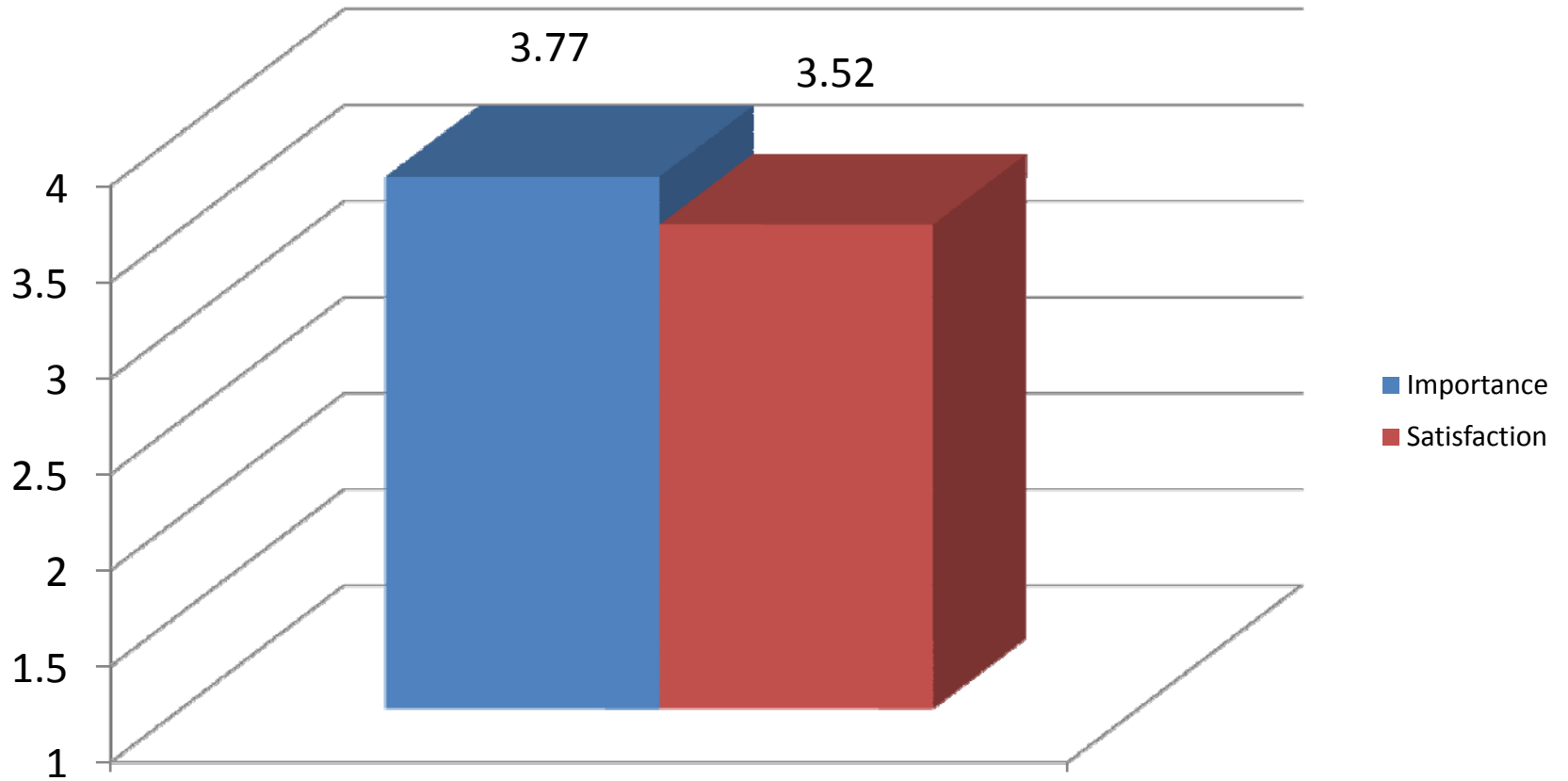
Question 1: Economics courses promote critical thinking and analytic skills:  $n = 31$  (I) and 33 (S)



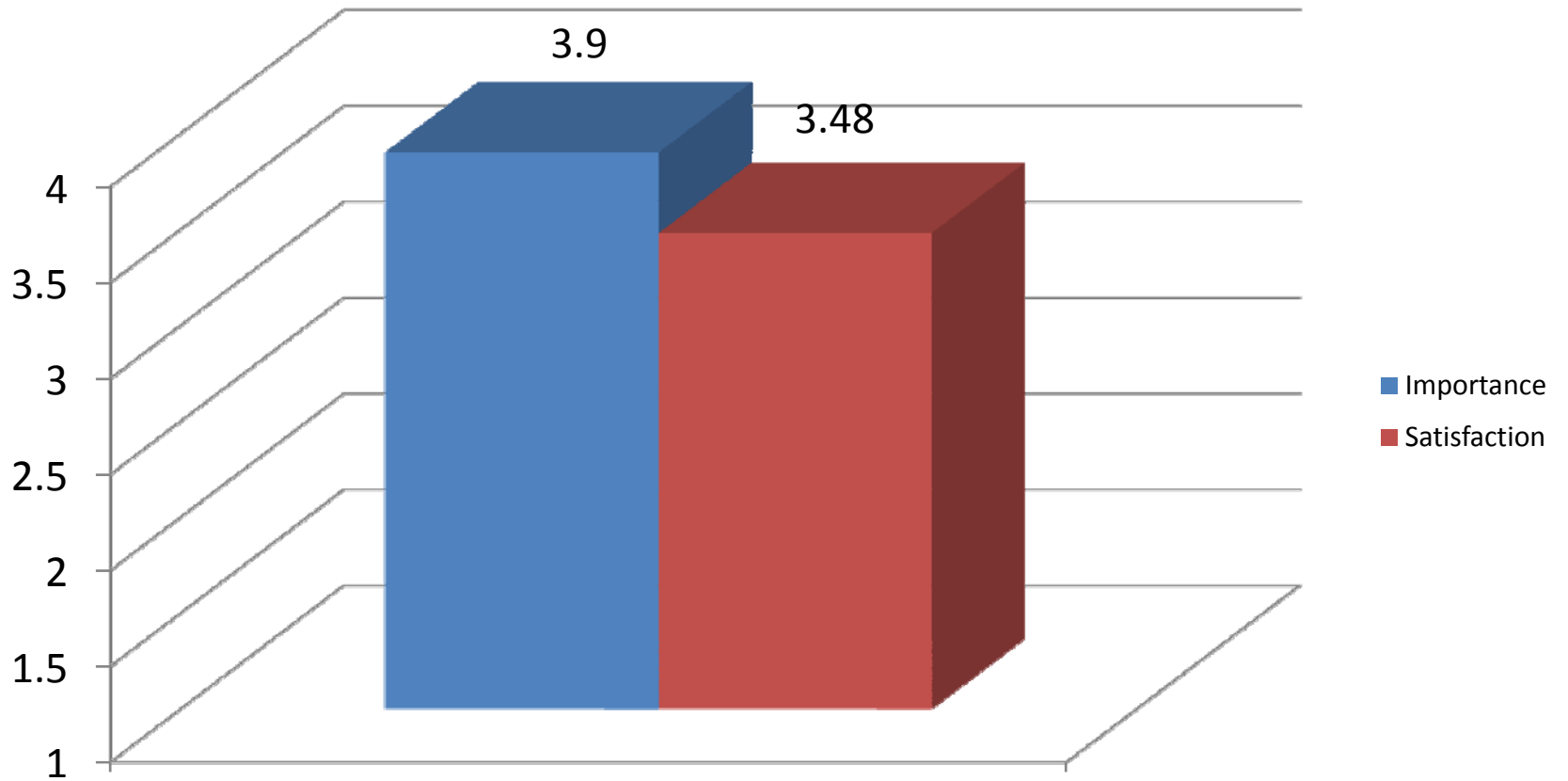
Question 2: Economics courses promote writing skills:  $n = 31$  (I) and  $32$  (S)



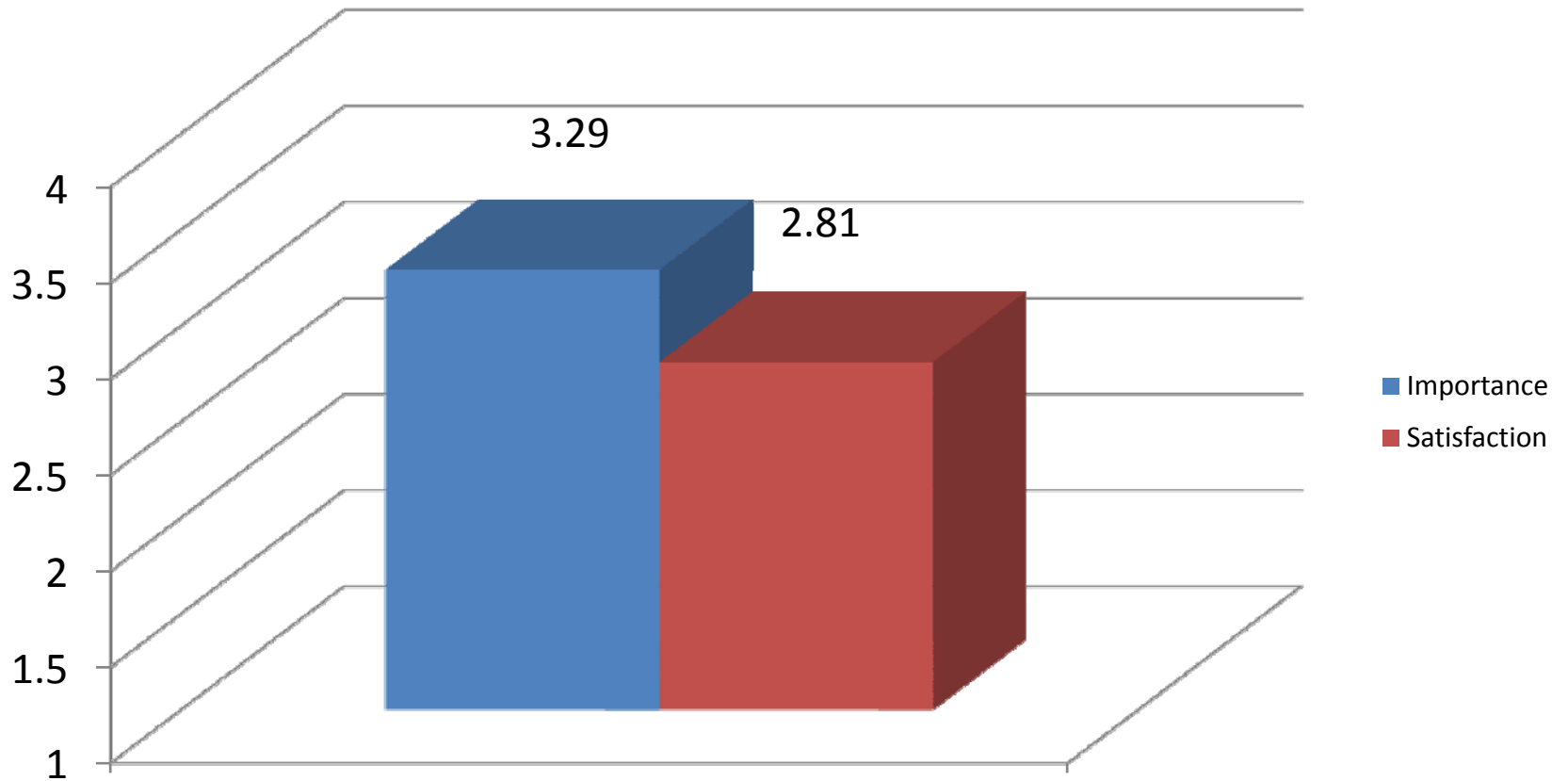
Question 3: Economics courses promote speaking skills:  $n = 31$  (I) and 33 (S)



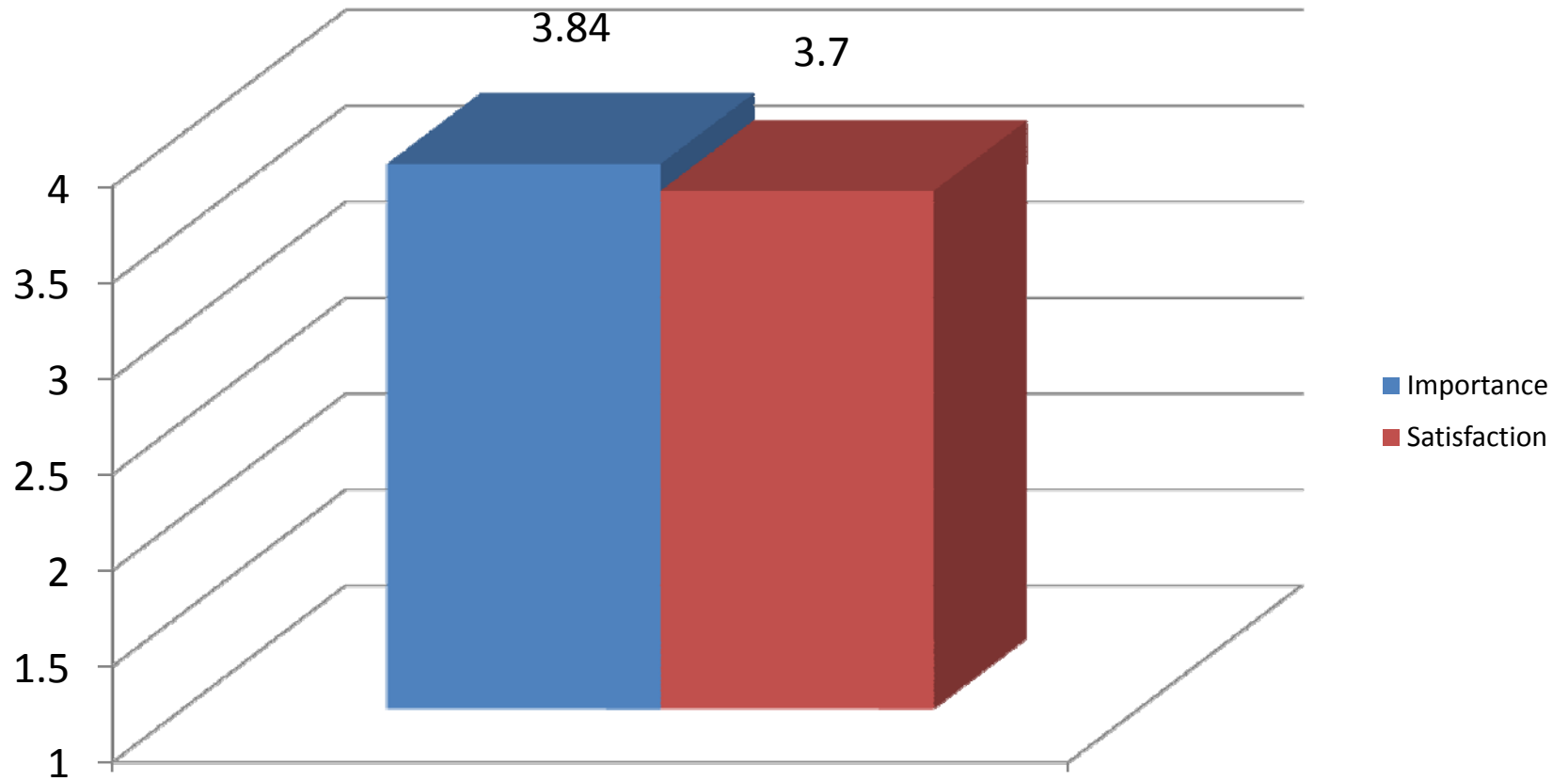
Question 4: Economics courses adequately prepared me for my planned career:  $n = 31$  (I) and 33 (S)
