

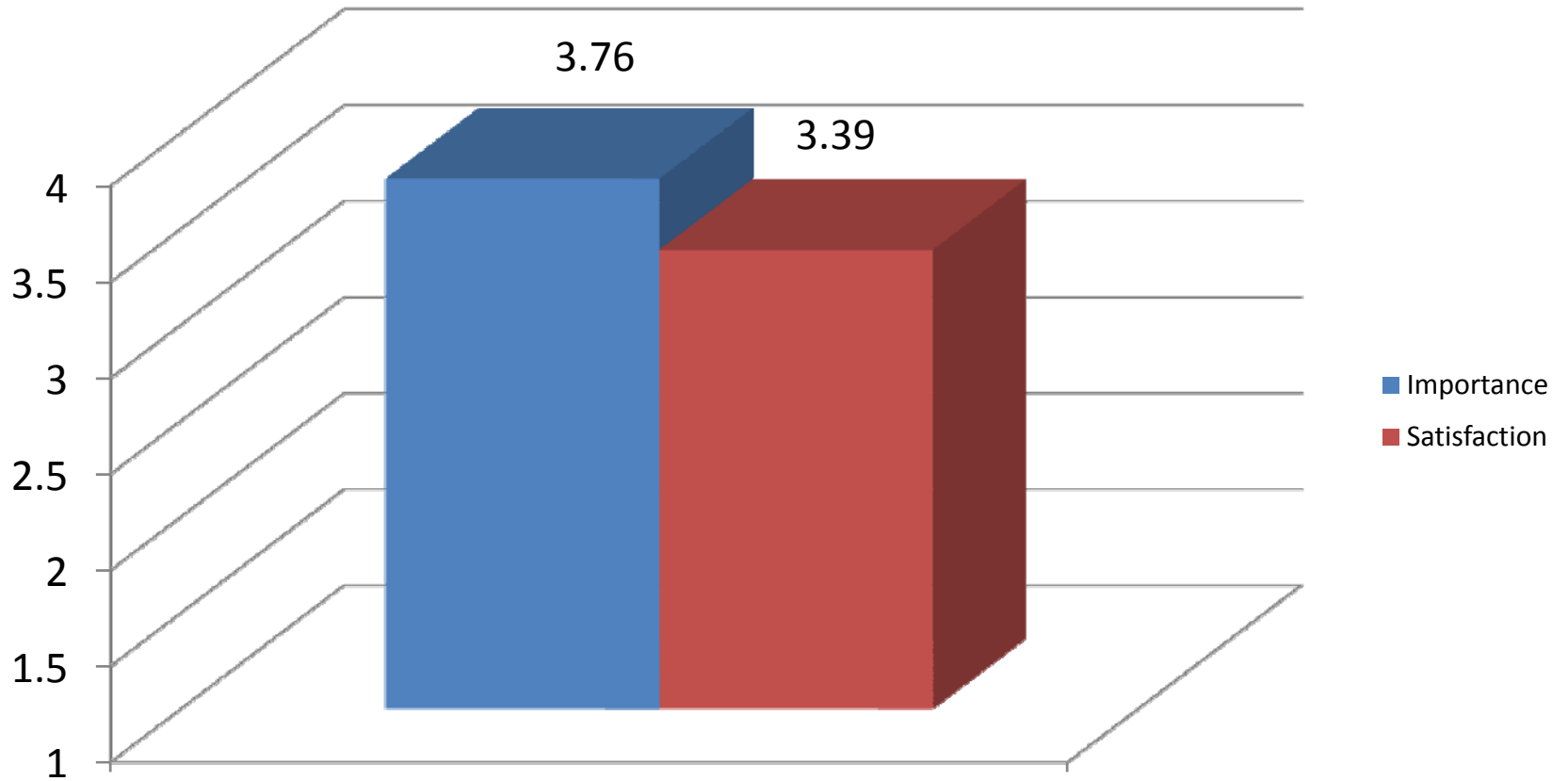

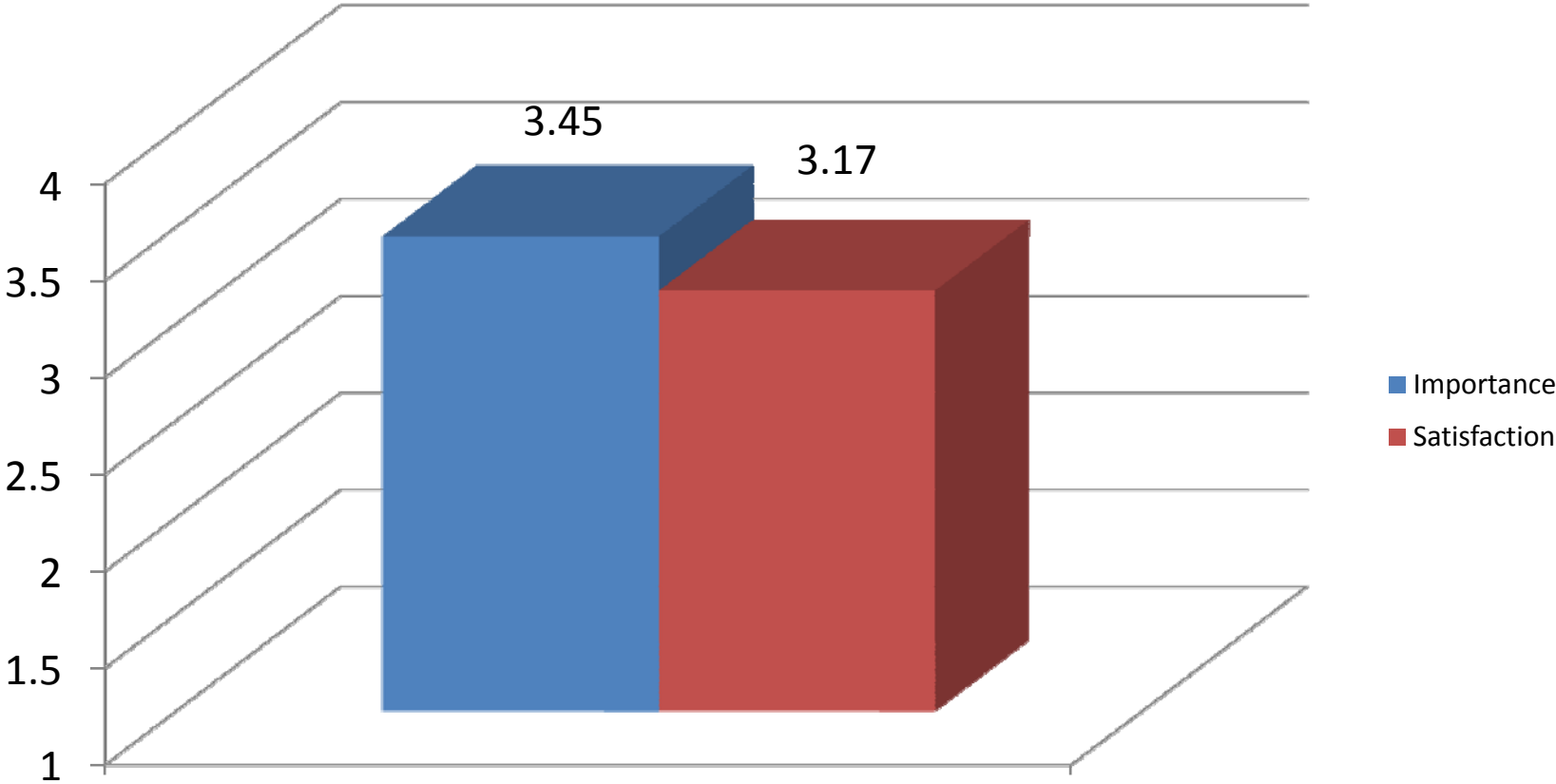
# Mean Comparisons for Importance and Satisfaction

Scale = 1 (Not important/Not satisfied) to 4 (Very important/Very Satisfied)

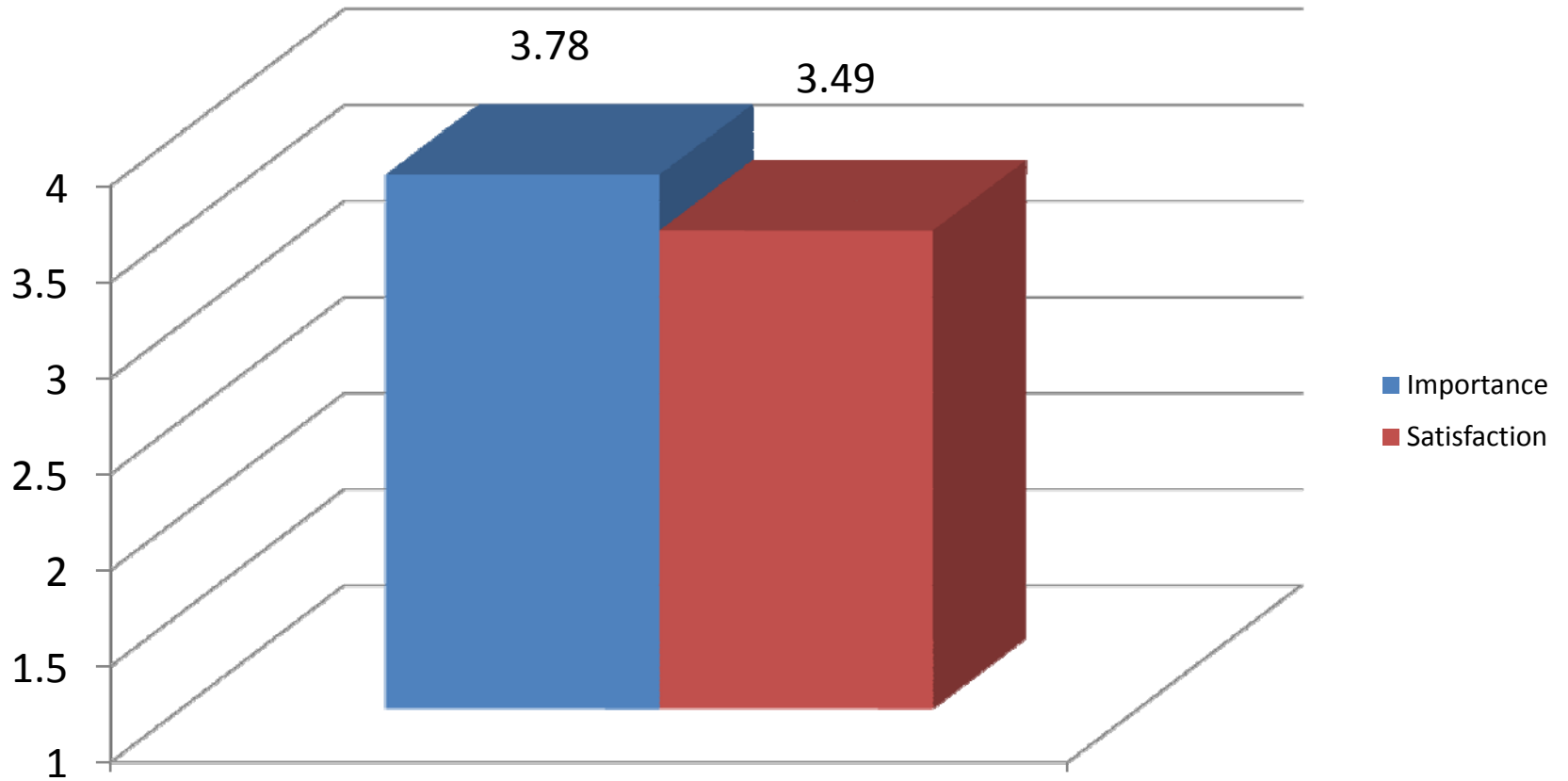
Question 1: Management courses promote critical thinking and analytic skills:  $n = 156$  (I) and 168 (S)



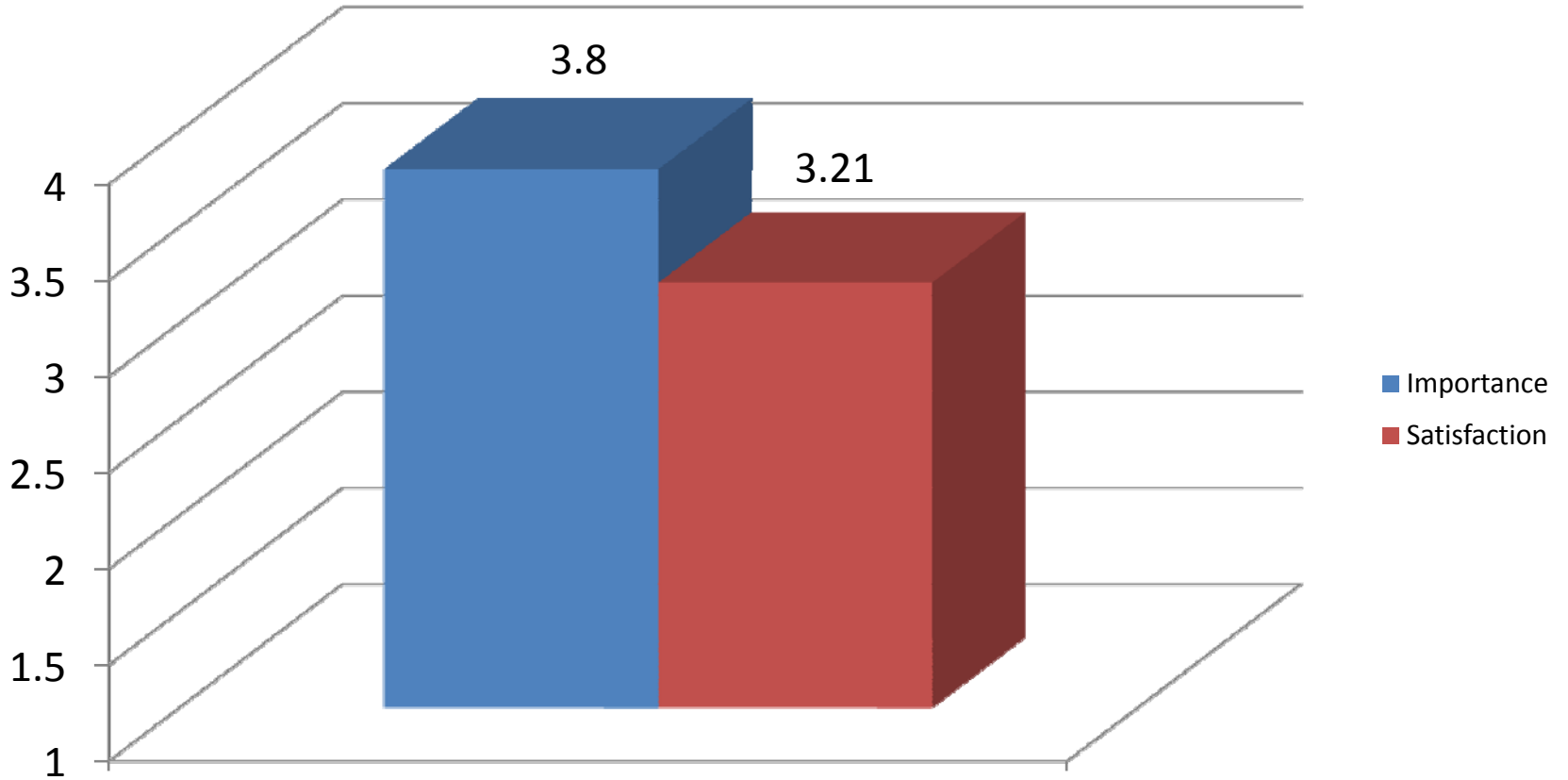
Question 2: Management courses promote writing skills:  $n = 157$  (I) and 169 (S)



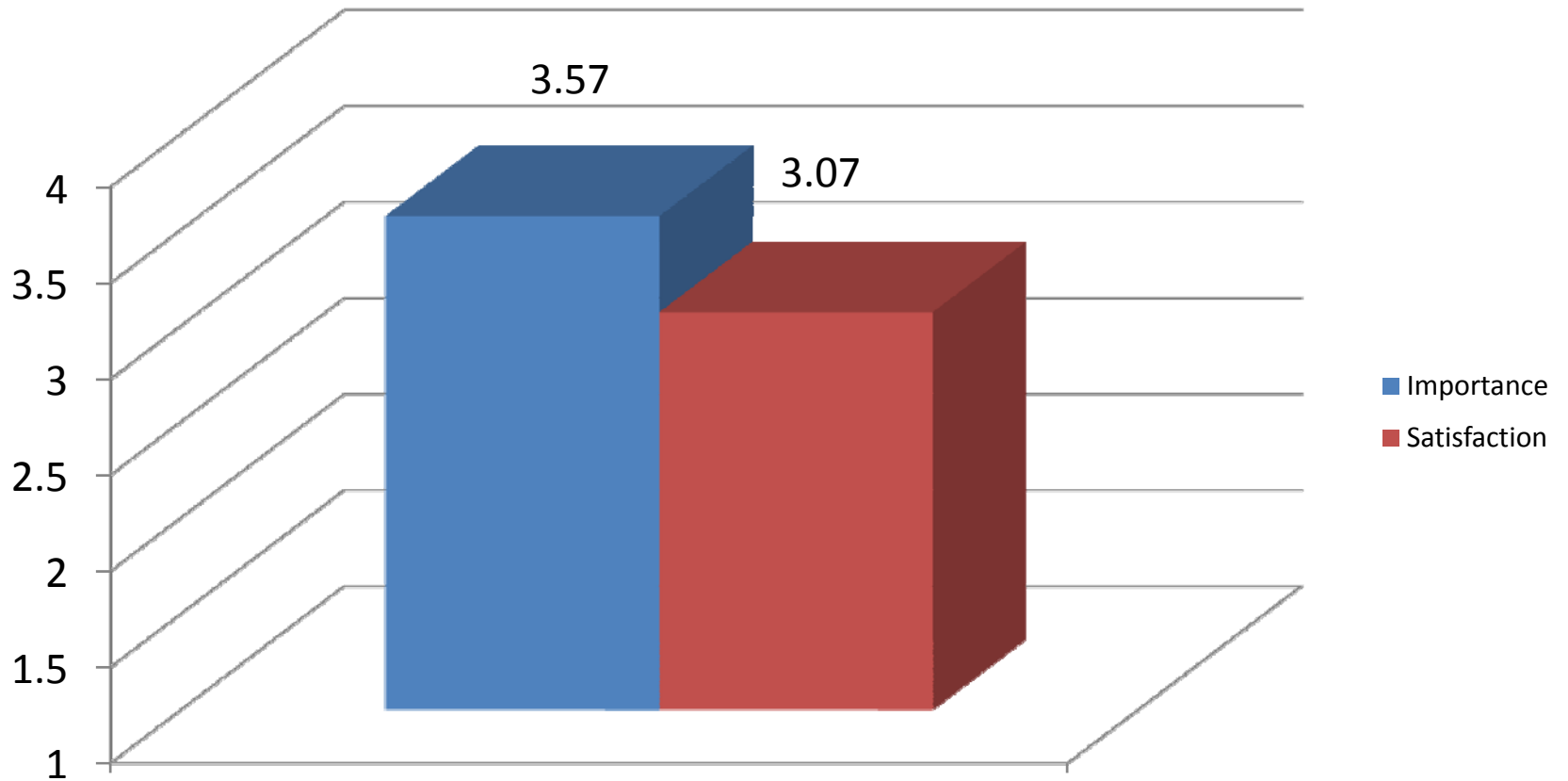
Question 3: Management courses promote speaking skills:  $n = 157$  (I) and 169 (S)



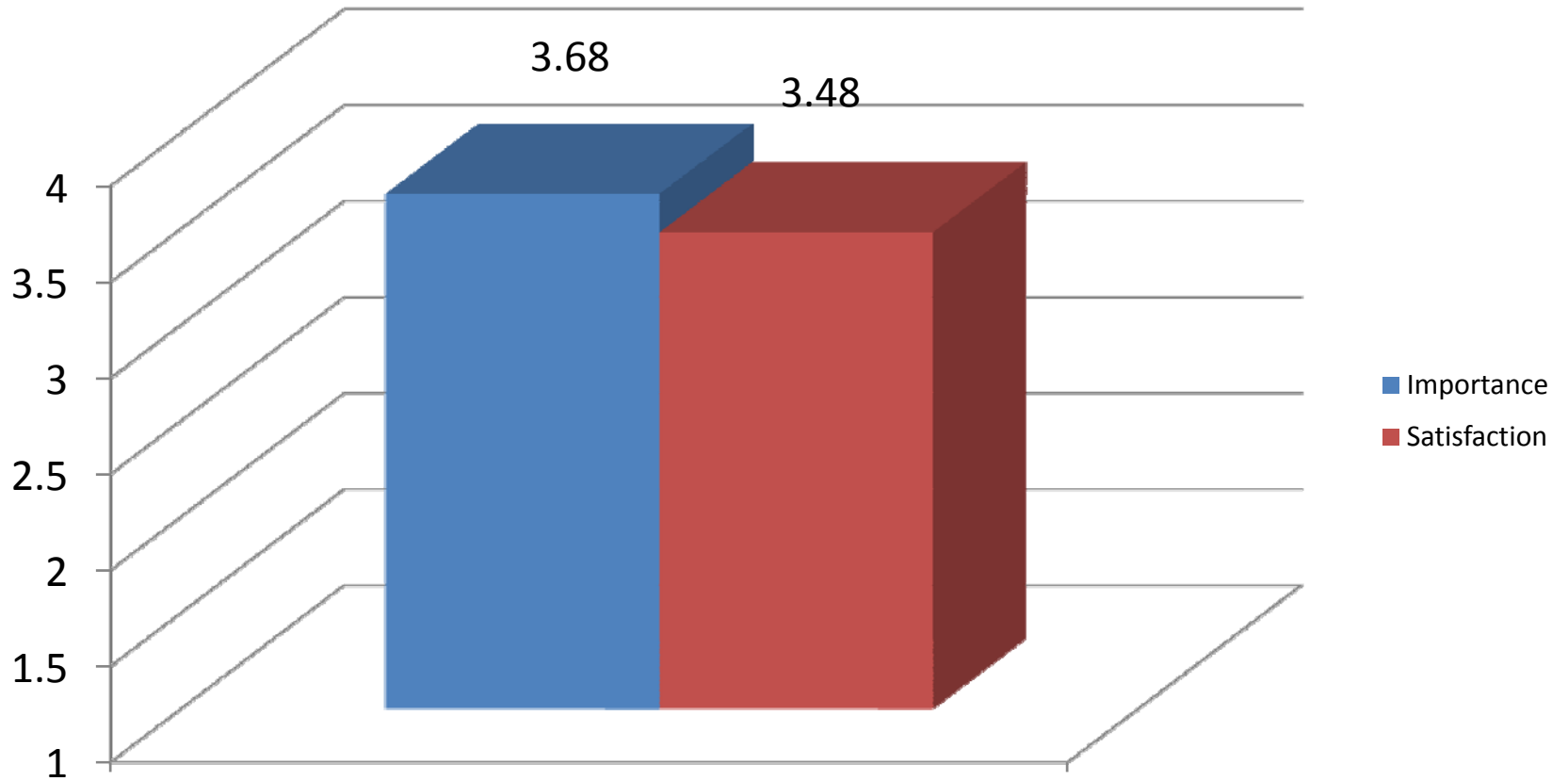
Question 4: Management courses adequately prepared me for my planned career:  $n = 157$  (I) and 168 (S)
