The Nomination Process

Please nominate as many of your 9th - 12th grade students as you would like, but please list them in the order that you would want them chosen. If you really want student "X" to come, then please place their name toward the top of your list. We will endeavor to include as many of your students as possible dependent upon the number of nominations we receive. Our goal is to include as many students as possible. At this time, we expect to seat three equal bands.

The Selection Process and Band Assignment

Registration is now open on our band website. www.marshall.edu/band. Please complete your registration form by January 20, 2017. Each entry will be placed in the order in which it was received. The first student from each school will be selected, followed by the second, and so on until all sections are filled based on instrumentation needed. Assignment to one of the three bands will be by audition assigned registration.

Check-in and Registration (Directors and representatives)

Check-in and registration for Directors and representatives will be on February 9, 2017, Thursday afternoon at 12:00 PM. NOTE: Auditions will be completed before the dinner hour and rehearsals begin Thursday evening! Check-in and registration will be in Smith Music Hall Room 123 (corner of 3rd Ave. and Hal Greer Blvd.). Parking instructions will be outlined in future correspondence.

Auditions & Audition Materials

Auditions will be held beginning at 2:00 PM. Thursday, February 9 at Smith Music Hall. They will be done slightly differently this year. Instead of assigning definite times for each group, you will be allowed to register your ensemble between 12:00 -1:30 PM and individual audition times will be assigned at that time. If you will not be able to register your students in that time frame, please contact us to work out another option. Audition materials for wind players are: major scales up to and including 4 sharps and 4 flats, chromatic scale and sight reading. Percussionists will be given a sight-reading exercise. Your students will be assigned an audition time upon arrival. Students may warm up in one of our practice rooms located on the second and third floor or in the band room. It is our goal to finalize the personnel in each band by Thursday afternoon before the dinner hour. A list will be emailed to each of you and posted around the School of Music and Henderson Center. Please have your students in the assigned rehearsal space on time Thursday to ensure rehearsals can begin on time.

Registration Fee

The cost of attending the MU Festival Band is \$25.00 per student. For this, each student receives a custom Festival Band Medal and a Festival Band T-Shirt. Checks should be made out to "MU Kappa Kappa Psi". We will also be accepting credit cards this year if it will help you out. Please pay the registration fees on Thursday, February 9 when you check in (Directors or their representatives only please).

Rehearsal & Concert Sites

Rehearsals for the "John Marshall" band will take place on the Smith Music Hall (SMH) stage; rehearsals for the "Thundering Herd" band will take place in the Smith Music Hall Band Room; rehearsals for "Marco's Marauders" band will take place in the Marching Thunder Band Complex located on Level A of the Henderson Center Basketball Arena. The band entrance is on the east side of Henderson Center through the doors with the Marching Thunder logo.

Festival Weekend and Concert Dress

Please ask your students to dress appropriately for the weekend. School clothes and jeans are fine. Please no provocative clothing. For the concert, please plan to wear band uniforms. Members of auxiliary squads (color guard, majorettes, etc.) should wear a regular band uniform if possible.

Music Stands

We ask that each school bring one music stand for every two students selected for the Festival. Baritone Saxes and horns, or other instruments not normally doubled should bring individual stands. This is very important because we do not own enough stands here at Marshall to provide stands for students at the festival. Please mark the stands clearly so you can quickly identify them at the conclusion of the festival and take them home.

Amenities

Each student is given a Festival Band medal and MU Festival Band T-shirt. The MU Chapter of the Society of Composers, Inc. will be recording the concert and offering CDs for \$12.00 outside of the Recital Hall in the hallway of Smith Music Hall the evening of the concert.

Meals

All campus dining facilities at the Memorial Student Center and Harless Dining Hall will be open. Students may also go off-campus to eat. There are several restaurants and fast food places within easy walking distance from campus.

Parking for Buses

Parking information for individuals and buses will be forwarded in the future via separate correspondence.

Directions

To Smith Music Hall from I-64, either direction: take Exit 11 (Hal Greer Boulevard), follow Hal Greer north all the way until you run into 3rd Ave. The music building will be on the corner, on your right. Third Avenue is a one-way street that runs west, toward town.

To Smith Music Hall from Hwy. 52 (Ohio): Take the ramp to your right to Chesapeake, Huntington near the end of Hwy. 52. You will be in Chesapeake, OH and will simply need to cross the bridge to be in Huntington. After you cross the bridge, look for 4th Ave. (don't worry if you pass it, simply turn left onto 5th Ave.), turn left onto 4th Ave. and follow it until it runs into Hal Greer Blvd. (5th runs into Hal Greer also). Take a left onto Hal Greer. The music building will be on your right.

School of Music Auditions and Marching Band Scholarship Auditions (seniors only)

Seniors wishing to audition for scholarships and entrance into the MU Department of Music and tuition scholarships through the marching band will have an opportunity to do so on Friday, during the 1:00 p.m. rehearsal. Students must complete the School of Music Application and submit it to the School of Music. They must also request an audition using the online form.
