- **myMU/MILO:** Terri announced that the UCS migration from Luminus 3 to Luminus 4 was successful. Terri stated that there were still a few outstanding issues with this migration. Terri informed the committee that the site specific modifications have not been performed at this time and the Targeted Announcement interface has changed which is causing problems with the usability of this feature. - **Document Imaging:** Terri announced that the needs assessment document has been sent to senior management for their input on the departments that will be chosen to pilot the implementation of the document imaging system.
- **New Hold Process:** Terri stated that there are still a few colleges/programs that haven't provided information to her regarding their hold types/users. The committee discussed a "go live" date for this process and the week of July 7th was chosen as the week to bring this process online.
- **Residency requirement Tracking Proposal:** Terri reported that the pilot group of students has been chosen and Residence Services is currently testing this process. Terri indicated that the residency requirement tracking should be in place for this summer's orientation. Terri informed the committee that the release codes would be stored in the Location Management system as Application Status code, should anyone need to view them.

Terri stated that Residence Services is looking for a third-party application for Housing/Location Management that provides more functionality than the current Banner system. An RFP has been created for this and it is currently under reviewed.

- **Banner 8:** Terri discussed the options that were being considered for the roadmap to Banner 8, which was released last month. Terri stated that Myke Watts was currently working on the steps necessary to update the current Banner database to Oracle 10g, which is a requirement for Fin Aid/Fin Aid Self-Service.
