 1. Current Structure of BANNER Users Groups – Bob Walker reviewed the Current structure of the BANNER Users Groups.  2. Policies and Procedures – Bob Walker stated that the policies that are in place for the BUG-Student also applied to the BUG-T. Terri Byrd suggested that all members become familiar with these policies and procedures.  3. BANNER Website – Terri Byrd asked if everyone knew about the Marshall BANNER website (<http://www.marshall.edu/banner/>). Terri reviewed some of the highlights of the website including the General Information, Banner Student Users Group, Functional Areas, and Manuals. Terri suggested that the BUG-T create their own area within this website. Pat Gebhart volunteered to look into this. Terri also suggested that the Alumni Development offices may want to look into using the Alumni/Development pages on the Marshall BANNER website.
 4. Reporting Tools / Data Marting – Bob Walker stated that there had been a great deal of discussion about the need for a solution that would allow end-users to create ad hoc reports across from the BANNER database. Terri stated that this group should develop criteria for evaluating different reporting tools and begin trying to find a tool (or set of tools) that would meet the needs of the university. Terri suggested that the BANNER-TECH-List be used as a

mechanism for discussing the tools and evaluation criteria. Terri Byrd stated that Oracle Reports was available for users who wanted to try using this reporting tool. Terri asked anyone interested in using Oracle Reports to contact her.

5. Current Projects – Mike McGuffey stated that he was currently working on getting the ZIP code table in BANNER populated with up-to-date information. Mike further stated that there had been a commitment to purchase a product from Mailers Software (<http://www.800mail.com>) that would allow him to update the BANNER ZIP code table.

Terri Byrd stated that she was working on the upgrade to BANNER 4.x. Terri explained that the current upgrade plan was to upgrade the Test database with the “baseline” BANNER 4.x product, then upgrade Preproduction and add the local modifications, and finally to upgrade production. Terri stated that Test should be upgraded and available in April with the Preproduction upgrade following sometime after that. Terri announced that the current plan was to have BANNER 4.x installed in production on the weekend of Memorial Day (weekend of May 27th, 2000) barring any unforeseen circumstances.

Deb Elliott stated that she had been working with an SCT consultant on population selection/letter generation for Alumni.

Bob Walker stated that he had been working on the Finance and Human Resources implementations.

6. Leadership Structure of the BANNER Technical Group – Terri Byrd suggested that the BUG-T needed a formal leadership structure. Terri stated that the group would need to determine who would represent the BUG-T at the BANNER Executive (Oversite) Committee. Bob Walker suggested that this topic be tabled until next meeting.
