- **Common Matching - Admissions**
 - Amy has been testing in PreProd and everything is working properly. It was originally thought to take away privileges to update SPAIDEN. In order to create person records people would be required to have access to GOAMTCH. Pat will find out who actually need to create person records. Amy will take the proposal to BOC and Oversight Committee. Those who currently have update privileges to SPAIDEN will continue to have that access. Marc Danner has ACT matching Rules which he will share to help define matching protocols.

NEW BUSINESS:

- **Criminal Justice** moving to the Department of Integrated Science and Technology in the College of Science.
- **Operational Data Store (ODS) and Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW)**
 - A consultant was hired to help with the installation of the ODS and EDW.
 - The ODS and EDW will be up and running in test next week. All reports will be actively pushed to ODS. So no reports will be run out of the production database.
 - ODS – Will be a live database only a few seconds behind the production database. Trending data will be stored. It will include all tables that exist in the production database.
 - EDW – There will eventually be dashboards where you can drill down to view data.
 - The first priority is getting both the ODS and EDW up and running then facilitate users to the ODS.
 - Job submissions (GJAPCTL) will still run against the production database.
 - ODS speaks conventional Oracle SQL.
