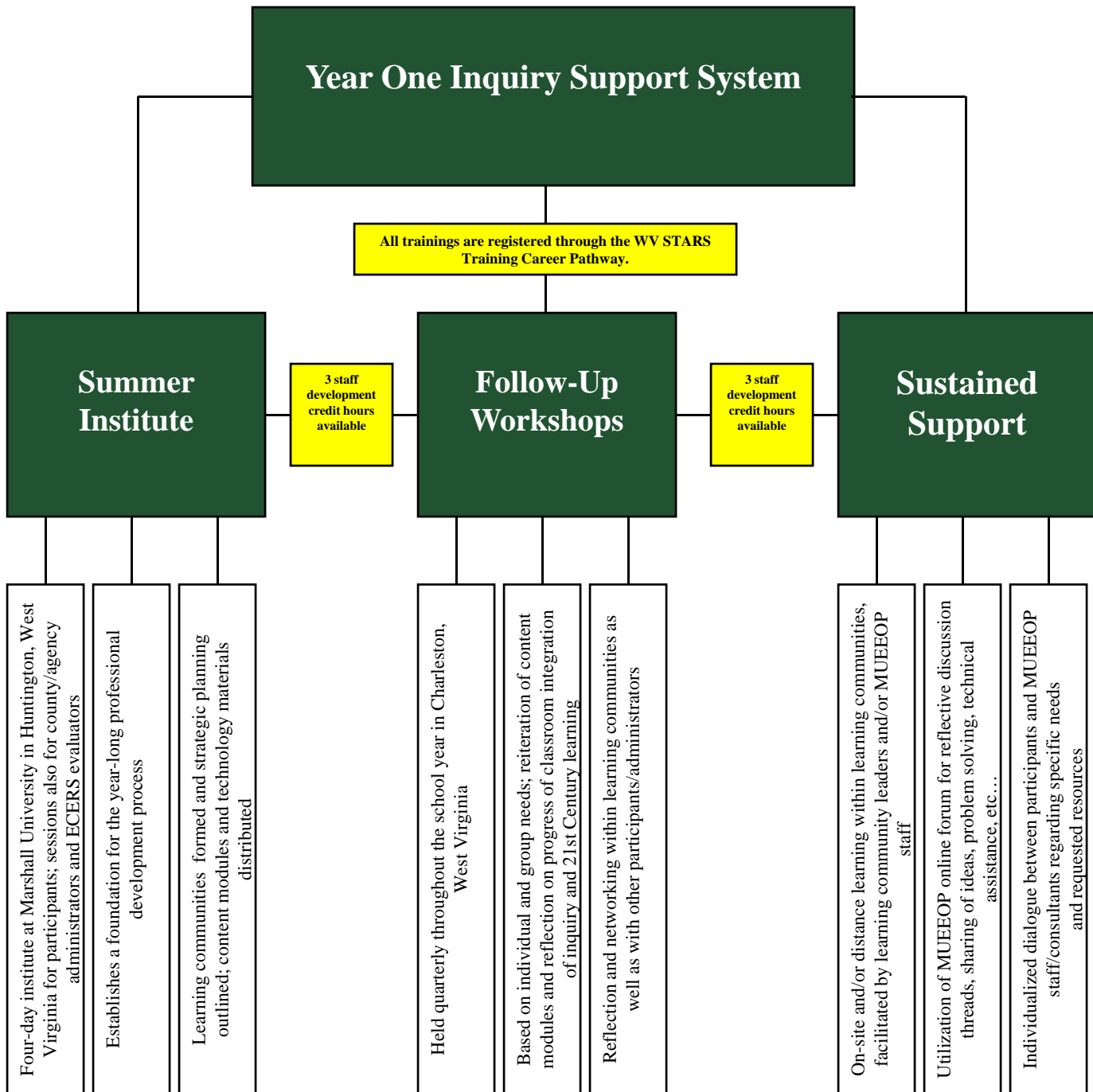
All training modules are designed to support Pre-K educators with implementation of current policies and assessment tools in place, including:

1. WV Pre-K Early Learning Standards Framework Content Standards and Objectives (WVBE Policy 2520)
2. WV 21st Century Content Standards and Objectives and Technology Tools for Pre-K 12 (WVBE Policy 2520.14)
3. Each county/agency's existing curricular framework
4. ECERS-R

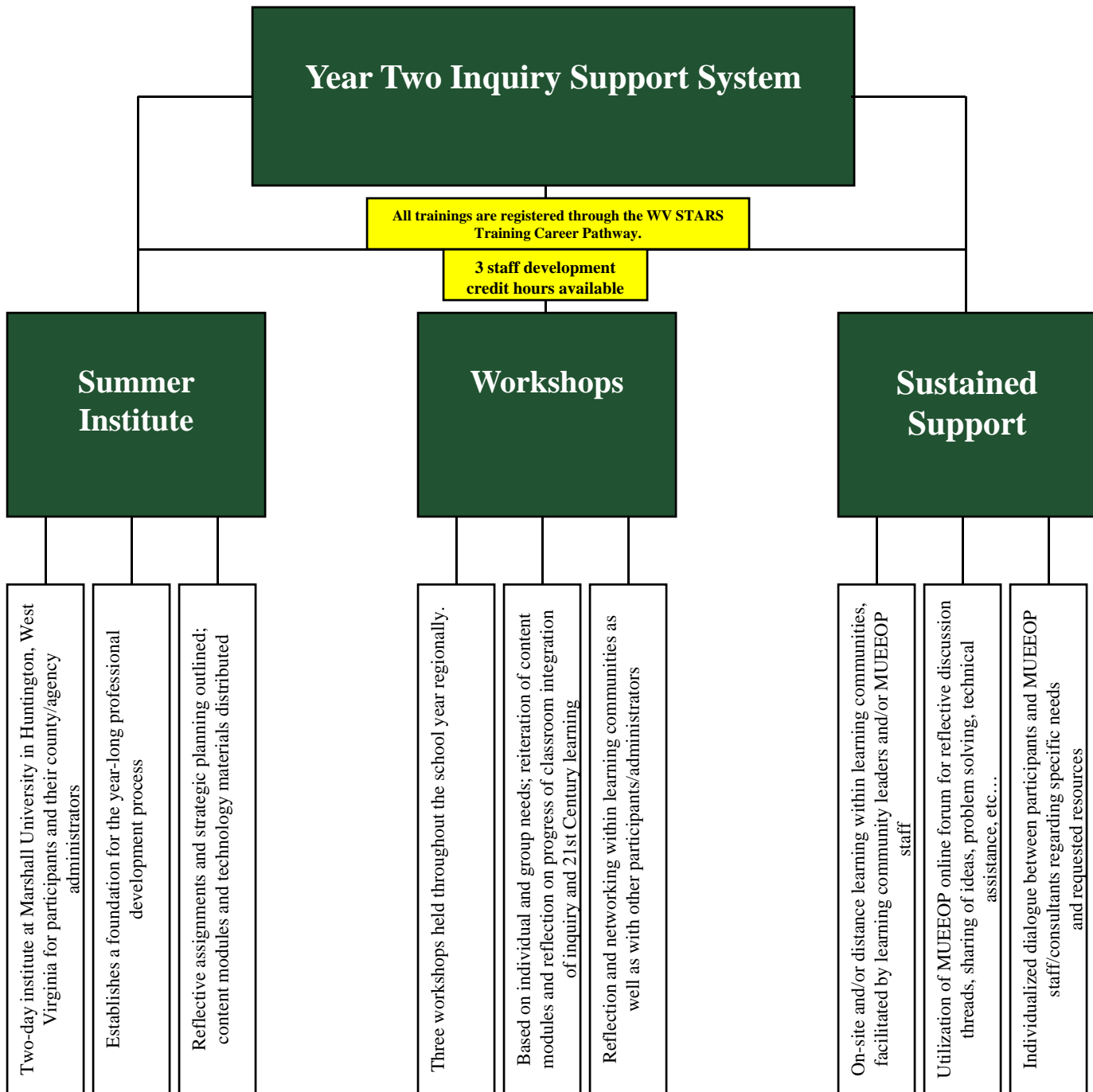
Features of the Inquiry Support System

- 1. Inquiry Support System: 21st Century, Inquiry-Based Professional Development for WV Pre-K Educators:**
 - a. 10-month professional development process (with an option for Year II participation)**
 - b. Strong emphasis on integration of 21st Century, inquiry-based learning into participants' existing curricular framework**
 - c. Technology component (provision of digital technology and training for integration into the Pre-K classroom with children)**
 - d. Designed for educators with a strong understanding of Pre-K best practice**
 - e. Administrator component provided to support participants throughout the process**

Registration Information—ISS

Registration for Year One and Year Two of Inquiry Support System is maintained by the Marshall University Early Education Outreach Program and takes place from December through May of the school year prior to participation. The ISS is heavily subsidized by a generous award from the Claude Worthington Benedum Foundation; however, a small percentage of the overall cost for participation must still be provided by the county/agency of which participants are employed.

2009-2010 Year One ISS Per-Participant Sponsorship=\$400

2009-2010 Year Two ISS Per-Participant Sponsorship=\$400

To help create shared meaning throughout the ISS process, all county/agency Pre-K administrators may attend all ISS events free of charge.

ISS Participant Sponsorship includes all registration fees for summer institute, follow-up workshops, and learning community meetings; accompanying modules and additional resources for each participant; digital camera and technology support for each participant*; online forum subscription; tote bag; and individualized support as requested.

*Additional digital camera bundles are \$135 each.

Up to six hours of staff development credit are available for participation in the Year One ISS (three for Fall semester and three for Spring semester). Undergraduate tuition=\$156 for three hours. Graduate tuition=\$189 for three hours.

Up to three hours of staff development credit are available for participation in the Year Two ISS. Tuition is the same as listed above.
