The Certificate Program in Literacy Education consists of six foundation courses and several assessments accessed on the Literacy Education site: <http://www.marshall.edu/wpmu/muonline>.

Coursework included as a part of this Plan of Study must not be older than seven years at the time of graduation. All coursework that candidates wish to transfer from other institutions must be approved by Marshall University within the first semester of classes. A plan of study must be completed, signed, and returned electronically to the Literacy Education secretary. This program *does not* lead to an *initial* teacher licensure in West Virginia. Program completers can apply to the West Virginia Department of Education for an additional endorsement to their *general* education teaching license. Candidates must apply for the certificate to complete the program. Information on applying for the completer certificate is posted on the LEP online site. Application for the certificate must be made by the published deadline in the semester of graduation. A hold will be placed on your account preventing registration for classes until the plan of study is returned and the Pre-Foundation test is complete.
