

GEOLOGY UNDERGRADUATE TUITION WAIVERS

One full-time tuition waiver has already been awarded for the Fall 2005 Semester. Another full-time tuition waiver will be offered in the Spring 2006 semester.

Eligibility

1. The waiver for Spring 2006 will be awarded to a full time B.A. or B.S. Geology major on a competitive basis.
2. Applicants must have completed GLY 110 or GLY 200, GLY 210L, and must have completed (or be enrolled in) any two of the following: GLY 201, GLY 212, GLY 313, GLY 314, GLY 325, GLY430, GLY 451 & 451L, GLY455 & 455L
3. (Transfer students must have completed equivalent courses)
4. **NOTE:** A student already receiving financial assistance, excluding a loan(s), that includes a tuition waiver for the Spring 2006 semester is not eligible for this award.

Application

1. Completed application form.
2. Photocopies of all college grade reports through Sept 1, 2005.
3. Applications are due by Dec. 1, 2005
4. Submit applications to the departmental secretary (Mrs. Janet Clark)

Selection

Applications will be evaluated by the geology faculty. Criteria for selection are in order of decreasing priority:

1. Academic achievement as indicated by grades and performance in upper level classes.
2. Participation in classroom, punctuality in attending class and turning in assignments, attendance and class preparation.
3. Financial need.
4. Commitment to geology giving consideration to service to department, involvement in the geology club and geological society membership(s).
