The Young Writers Contest celebrates and expects original work from students at every grade level. **Plagiarism** is using part or all of someone else's work and taking credit for it as your own. It is unethical behavior. The Young Writers Contest follows Marshall University's policy against plagiarism. In accordance with this policy, all Young Writer entries will be submitted to the anti-plagiarism tool, SafeAssign.
