

PROFESSIONAL DOCTORATE IN FORENSIC SCIENCE - SURVEY

The Marshall University Forensic Science Center is conducting a survey of working forensic science professionals and students to determine their perceived need, or desire to achieve, a Professional Doctorate Degree in Forensic Science. This program will be designed for working professionals whereby the majority of coursework will be provided through a secure internet link of the program's home website. It is envisioned that educational technologies such as podcasts, webinars, MP3 downloads, and real-time group meetings will be considered for incorporation into this program. It is also envisioned that prior graduate-level basic science and forensic science coursework, as well as work experience in the field, will provide a solid foundation for entry into such a program. It is likely that a M.S. in Forensic Science would be required for entry into this doctoral program and that graduates from FEPAC-accredited programs would be given preference.
