1. The course will be taught by different faculty so how will this be handled? What features of the course will be common to ensure that all sections meet the

requirements of both CT and MC? This explanation should be submitted in the most recent form for CT.

2. There should be some differentiation in the ways that students practice and assess the different outcomes. This is not clear in the submission form since each outcome seems to be practiced and assessed in the same way. Please provide the council more examples from the syllabus how the outcome will be 1) practiced and 2) assessed across multiple sections of the course.

HST 103 – tentatively approved with approval from the GEC Chair after the following concern is addressed: Quizzes and exams are listed in the practice column. How are they used in the classroom as a way for students to practice these outcomes?

CL 237 – tentatively approved with approval from the GEC Chair after the following concern is addressed: the student project should be summarized and described for the committee rather than the directions provided for the student – which outcomes does it measure and what is the percentage of the students final grade?; please revise the practice column to include how the assignment facilitates the listed learning objectives; participation is a part of the grade so are these from the discussions that are mentioned in the outcomes table? Please make this clearer; the syllabus is missing catalog course description and an updated link to university policies; in the syllabus, please delete the reference to the old Marshall CT domains – these can be updated to link to the BDP outcomes.

CL 232 – tentatively approved with approval from the GEC Chair after the following concern is addressed: the student project should be summarized and described for the committee rather than the directions provided for the student – which outcomes does it measure and what is the percentage of the students final grade?; For BDP and course outcomes table, the practice column appears as objectives rather than course activities. Please revise these as to provide more details; the rough drafts/discussions should be moved to practice column since it appears that discussions are not officially graded; the syllabus is missing the following: the course catalog description, link to university policies and the points are not clear how they add up to 1000.

CL 210 – tentatively approved with approval from the GEC Chair after the following concern is addressed: the "ungraded" part relating to the final exam should be in the practice column and the link to the university policies should be updated.
