Pot Luck

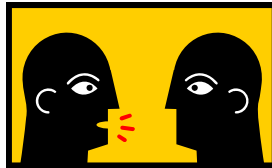
—Bring whatever and let random rule it delicious. The Graduate Humanities Program will provide drinks, ice, plates, and cutlery.

DIRECTIONS

From MUGC

- Go 1.9 miles (from MUGC) on Kanawha Turnpike West
- Left on Spring Hill Ave
- Go .5 miles to Little Creek Park
- Go .4 miles to Charles Hagerman Way
- Left and immediately Left again into the parking lot of Shelter #4

From I-64

- From the East, take Exit 55, Kanawha Turnpike (Follow MUGC directions)
- From the West, take Exit 54, MacCorkle Ave
- Right on MacCorkle Ave
- Next Right onto Jefferson Road
- Stay in right lane, and go .4 miles to stoplight
- Right on Kanawha Turnpike
- Left on Spring Hill Ave and go .5 miles
- Left into Little Creek Park
- Go .4 miles to Charles Hagerman Way
- Left and immediately Left again into the parking lot of Shelter #4
