- 3. Only those organizations, teams and residence hall buildings who have officially registered for Homecoming Thunder Cup may compete and be considered for prizes.

- 5. Though you are not required to participate and compete in all events, it is to your advantage to participate in as many as possible to acquire the most amount of points.
- 6. You must provide an up-to-date active member roster by October 5, 2017 at 12:00pm to the Office of Student Activities. (MSC2W40)

## **JUDGING OF HOMECOMING EVENTS**

- 1. Each event will be judged on the criteria listed in the Homecoming Registration Packet. All events will be scored by judges.
- 2. Judges will be given a range of points that can be allotted for each event. Points will then be tallied and put in rank order to determine the winner.
- 3. The highest and lowest scores from the judges will be dropped from each event.
- 4. The organizations with the highest number of points at the end of Homecoming Week in their respective categories will awarded the "Thunder Cup" trophy and the money collected during Penny Wars within their organization category.
- 5. Bonus points will be awarded for organizational attendance during the Bonfire and the Unity Walk. If 80% or more of your active member roster is in attendance, your organization will receive five (5) bonus points for each event.
- 6. Judges for each event will be decided by the Homecoming Committee.
- 7. Judges will be comprised of students, faculty, staff and/or alumni of Marshall University.
- 8. Decisions by the judges are final. There will be no appeals.
- 9. After the judging has been completed for each event, approaching judges and entrants will not be allowed.
- 10. Concerns, suggestions and questions may be addressed in writing to the Homecoming Committee by sending an email to homecoming@marshall.edu.

Event Description: Contestants will be asked to create a banner to be used on the Homecoming week.

Entry Form Due: Friday, September 29, 2017 by 12:00 p.m.

Student Activities Office, MSC 2W40

Event Date/Location: October 2-9, 2017

Requirements: 1. Organizations must submit a sketch of banner idea with the registration form.

2. Only members within your organization may work on your pomp. You are prohibited from receiving help from outside individuals. Outside help will result in immediate disqualification from the event.

3. After judging on Monday, you may leave your banner hanging in the MSC Lobby until the parade. Then you must take your banner to be added to your float. You may also add any extra decorations and make any additional adjustments you would like. These additions will not be factored into your score.

5. Banners must be placed on your organization's float within the Homecoming Parade in order to receive points awarded.

#### **PENNY WARS**

## **Event Information**

Event Description: The rules of a penny war are simple. The organization with the most pennies in its

jar wins. However, silver coins and paper money, count against the team. So, teams donate pennies to their own jars while also putting silver coins and paper money into their competitors' jars. There is no limit to the number of times a person can donate to any of the jars. The small and large organizations that win the Thunder Cup will receive all

of the funds collected within their respective size category.

5. Students can "bomb" another organization's jar by dropping other coins or

dollar bills.

## **CANNED FOOD ART**

## **Event Information**

Event Description: Contestants will be tasked to build a self-sustaining structure out of canned food that is

related to the Homecoming theme.

Event Date/Location: Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at 12:00pm

MSC Plaza (Rain location: MSC Lobby)

Requirements: 1. A minimum of 100 cans is required to start.

2. Building space consists of an 8'L x 8'W area.

3. Teams may have as many members on each team as desired, however only five members may be inside the group's designated construction zone at any given time.

4. Aluminum cans of all sizes may be used. No open or exposed food allowed. All labels must be intact and legible.

5. No glass containers may be used in the structures formation.

6. Each team's structure must be self-supporting.

7. No liquid adhesives, such as glue, may be used in building your structure. You are permitted to use tape, however it cannot be placed on the actual lables of the cans. Labels must be intact in order for the items to be donated.

8. Teams may begin building structure at the designated time and will finish construction when instructed to do so, at which time judging will begin.

9. You may use up to five additional props/items/clothing but these cannot be used for structural support.

#### HOMECOMING COURT GUIDELINES

#### Candidate Nomination

Candidates must have a sponsorship from a university recognized student organization or team, residence hall floor or association. The sponsoring group must fill out the sponsorship form and attach a letter of recommendation for the candidate. The sponsoring group may only sponsor ONE candidate. Sponsorship form and letter of recommendation are due by September 27, 2017 at 12:00pm. These must be presented in person at the Office of Student Activities, MSC 2W40.

#### **Candidate Requirements**

- Must be sponsored by a recognized student organization or team, or residence hall floor or association.
- Must be a student currently enrolled and in good standing at Marshall University
- Minimum GPA of 2.75
- Must complete an application and must give permission to the Office of Student Affairs to review GPA, conduct, and overall university status.
- Must be willing to allow picture and biographical information to be used in the promotion of Homecoming activities
- Must participate in an interview with a committee of judges on Monday, October 10, 2016
- Must participate or be in attendance at Homecoming activities sponsored by the Office of Student Activities such as Meet the Court, the Unity Walk, the parade and bonfire, etc.
- Students cannot be sponsored by more than one recognized student organization or team, or residence hall floor or association
- Must be able to fulfill all duties as Mr. or Miss Marshall as outlined in this packet or your title will be revoked

#### **Selection of Homecoming Court**

- Informational meetings for all candidates. You must attend at least one in order to be eligible for court selection. Failure to attend will result in removal from candidacy.
- Candidates must submit the application packet by 12:00pm on September 27 in person at the Office of Student Activities, MSC 2W40. Candidates must ensure that they have a sponsoring organization that has turned in the sponsorship packet and recommendation letter as well.
- Students will be notified if their candidacy is accepted and if they are eligible to campaign. This notification will be done by email on the afternoon of Friday, September 29.
- Eligible candidates can campaign from the time of candidacy notification to the completion of the first vote.
- Voting will take place October 2-6 and will close at 5:00pm. Voters will have the ability to select up to three (3) candidates from both Mr. and Miss Marshall
- The top female and top male\*\*\* candidates, as demonstrated by the first vote for Homecoming Court, will receive a phone call to schedule interviews. Unsuccessful candidates will get an email notification.
- Interviews will be conducted October 10-12 in the Memorial Student Center. Candidates will be given an interview score that will be combined with student votes to determine Mr. and Miss Marshall. (Inter views 30% Votes 70%)
- Scores will be calculated and verified by the Office of Student Affairs.
- The court will be announced at the Unity Walk celebration on Monday, October 9 at 5:00pm. All candidates will receive the details of this event in advance.
- Each member of the court will need to secure a car to participate in the Homecoming parade.

• The winners of Mr. and Miss Marshall will be announced at halftime of the Homecoming football game.

#### Campaigning

- Campaigning is restricted to Marshall students ONLY.
- Families, friends, faculty and staff cannot assist in campaigning.
- Candidates may not campaign using alcohol or drugs. Any reference to alcohol or drugs will not be tolerated.
- All University policies must be followed during campaigning, including:
  - -Food guidelines
  - -Sign posting guidelines
  - -Student Code of Conduct
- Candidates may not negatively reference other candidates in their campaign. Be respectful!
- Candidates may continue to campaign on the days of voting.

- Interviews will be conducted October 10-12 in the Memorial Student Center
- Announcement of the Court will be at the Unity Walk on October 9 at 5pm
