# **JOB SUMMARY**

The Applications Programmer provides system-level support of information systems, including installation, configuration, maintenance, and support of these systems.

## **NATURE OF WORK**

The Applications Programmer is responsible for reviewing, analyzing and occasionally modifying systems including developing, testing, debugging and installing to support the institution's information systems. Job responsibilities require a working knowledge of relational databases, web and client-server concepts, and the ability to rely on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals. Work is performed under limited supervision, working from established policies and objectives. Problems faced are varied, complex and occasionally ill-defined, which may require some analysis to understand. Errors could easily result in moderate costs and inconveniences within the affected area.

Performs requirements analysis to gain an understanding of business needs to develop level of effort estimates, software integration design and development, testing, performing design and code reviews, and development of technical documentation.

Develops and prepares documents for the general design of solutions that meet system and security requirements, including the selection of alternative approaches.

Serves as liaison with users concerning requests, usage, standards, security, and other developmental and production matters. Reviews and analyzes the effectiveness and efficiency of existing systems and develop strategies for improving or further leveraging these systems.

Develops guidelines and upgrade techniques of new operational procedures for the support of databases, hardware systems, operating systems software, network systems software, security and client server systems.

Performs other job related duties as assigned.
