JOB SUMMARY

The Landscape Worker plans, organizes, coordinates, and performs landscaping activities on campus.

NATURE OF WORK

The Landscape Worker is responsible for maintaining and caring for the exterior appearance of institutional buildings, as well as lawns, plantings, and surrounding grounds. Additional responsibilities may include organizing, setting priorities, scheduling, and reviewing work of student workers or volunteers. Job responsibilities contribute to ensuring the cleanliness, aesthetic, maintenance, and operation of campus grounds. Work is closely supervised, with limited opportunity for independent action or decision-making, and consists of tasks that are routine, or well-defined, with specific instructions to achieve standards. Decisions are infrequent and errors could result in minor inconveniences and costs within the affected area.

Distinguishing Characteristics

Examples of Duties

Essential Functions

Maintains and cares for the exterior appearance of institutional buildings, lawns, planting, and grounds around the campus utilizing hand tools, walk-behind equipment, and small riding equipment.

Maintains grounds including care of trees, grass, shrubs, and flowers.

Applies technical or process knowledge; requires capacity to understand specific needs or requirements to apply skills/knowledge.

Serves as liaison regarding buildings, grounds, and minor repairs.

Operates and maintains equipment such as large mowers, tillers, front-end loaders, and snow plows.

Performs inspections of buildings to identify maintenance and repair needs.

Maintains inventory of supplies needed to maintain buildings and equipment

Performs other job related duties as assigned.

Additional Responsibilities

May oversee and direct the work activities of student workers.

Performs other functions as required or assigned. Also complies with all Policies and Standards.
