Candidate must have the ability to contribute to Marshall University's commitment to cultural diversity and pluralism. The selected candidate will also contribute to the University's general education curriculum, with its emphasis on a common First-Year Seminar and core curriculum courses that enhance students' critical thinking and the College's support of interdisciplinary programs of study.
