

Marshall University Innovation Catalyst Program

Spring 2026 Application

Program Overview

The Innovation Catalyst Program begins with a semester-long training that prepares faculty and staff to become masters of design thinking and to champion it within their departments. Innovation Catalyst (IC) candidates receive hands-on training in Design for Delight (D4D) principles, equipping them to lead innovation efforts, support colleagues, and foster a community of creative problem-solving across campus.

Upon completing the training, candidates are launched as Innovation Catalysts (ICs) – serving as go-to resources for design thinking in their units. By helping colleagues apply D4D and fostering a culture of innovation, ICs lead their departments to become more collaborative, creative, and responsive to the needs of those they serve.

Program Expectations

- Weekly Training Sessions: IC candidates are required to attend weekly, in-person sessions every Wednesday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. throughout the Spring 2026 semester.
- Active Participation: Full engagement in training, activities, and assignments is expected.
- **Post-Training:** After being launched, ICs will continue driving and supporting D4D implementation within their departments. ICs will also receive continuing education and opportunities to connect with each other.
- Institutional Support: Applicants must receive support from their Supervisor and Dean/VP to ensure they have the time to participate fully.

Eligibility

Those who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply:

- Faculty or staff at Marshall University
- Excited to apply and share D4D within their department, even when it's challenging
- Prior participation in Design for Delight (D4D) training (preferred but not required)
