



## MUNET AND MUID

At Marshall University, your logon credentials are comprised of two separate ID's, an MUNET login username and an MUID number. Each credential is used for specific roles and purposes, and together allows you to have access to numerous resources within the Marshall University network.

### **The MUNET login ID, also known as the MUNET username:**

All students receive an MUNET Login username that enables access to our Marshall University network and computing infrastructure. Your MUNET login username is the credential that you will use to logon to more than 500 lab computers located on campus, access the campus-wide wireless network, and access your network resources, like your V: drive, personal webpages, Live Mail, Google Apps, etc. Your MUNET login username is an alphanumeric phrase based on your last name and a sequence number, for example smith344.

### **MUID Number, a 9 Digit Student ID Number:**

As a student of Marshall University, you will also receive an MUID number. Your MUID number is a unique 9 digit number that will allow you to access Marshall University's myMU, MILO, and MUOnline secured student web services. Your MUID number is the number found on your MU Student I.D. card. Commonly referred to as your 901 number, your student I.D. is a very important and frequently used credential that should be protected, and not shared.

Every student at Marshall is provided with a Student I.D. card. The student I.D. card will display your MUID number, and will be used as your primary identification for school business. Not only will your student I.D. quickly identify who you are and your affiliation with Marshall, your ID will also serve as your key to many of Marshall University's resources. Your student ID card can be used to provide swipe access to different areas and resources Marshall provides such as the Drinko study center, study rooms, print services, laundry services, snack machines, etc.

Your MUID number is used by the faculty and administrators as an easy way to verify who you are, and to help determine how we can best help you. Essentially, your MUID is your "passport" to all of the schools IT resources. Both of these credentials are extremely important to you as a student and should be protected, and kept safe.

### **Google Apps:**

Google Apps is one of Marshall University's newest services being offered to students. In conjunction with our Microsoft Live@edu service, Google Apps and Microsoft Live@edu have extended the online resources we offer to students. Enterprise class resources from Microsoft and Google are available to students from home or from on campus. You can access Live@edu services from myMU, and Google Apps can be accessed from <http://gapps.marshall.edu>.
