## RESIDENCE HALL WIRED CONNECTION FOR MAC

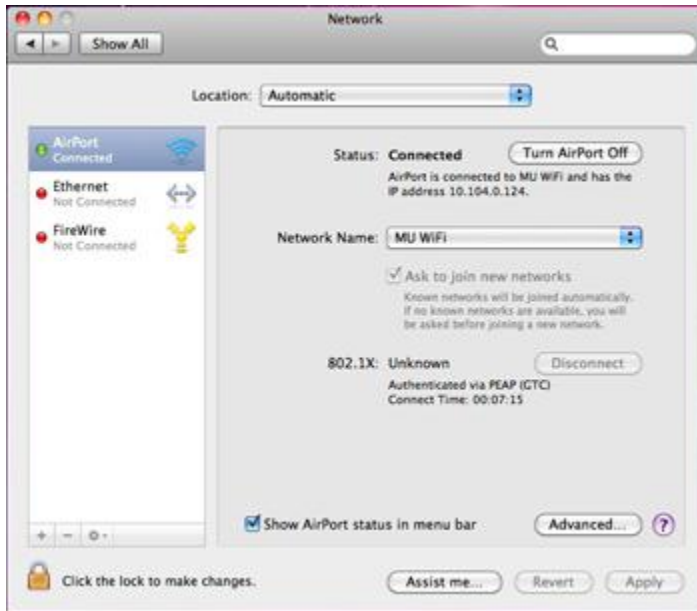
Set up your computer and connect the network cable to the network card. Use a network cable, not a telephone line and then connect your network cable to the network jack. (see image below)



### Connecting to the Cisco NAC Agent for Macintosh

1. If your computer has a wireless access card, disable it to ensure the wired connection is active. To do this, click the airport icon in the menu bar, and click "Turn Airport Off."

2. Open your web browser. (Usually Safari).



3. You will be redirected to the login page. Login using your MUNet ID and password.

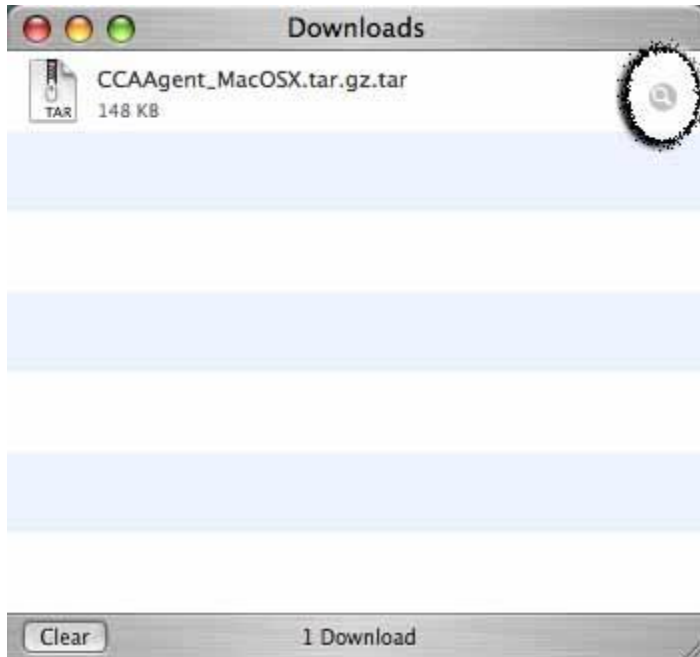

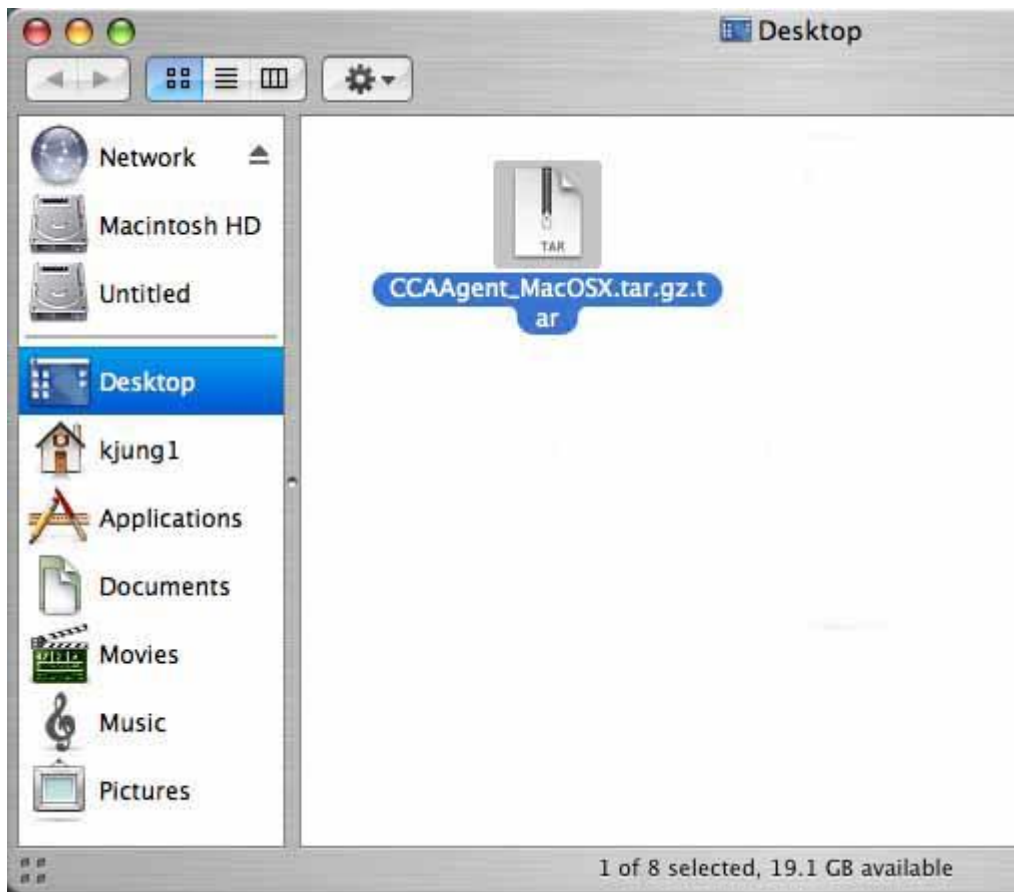

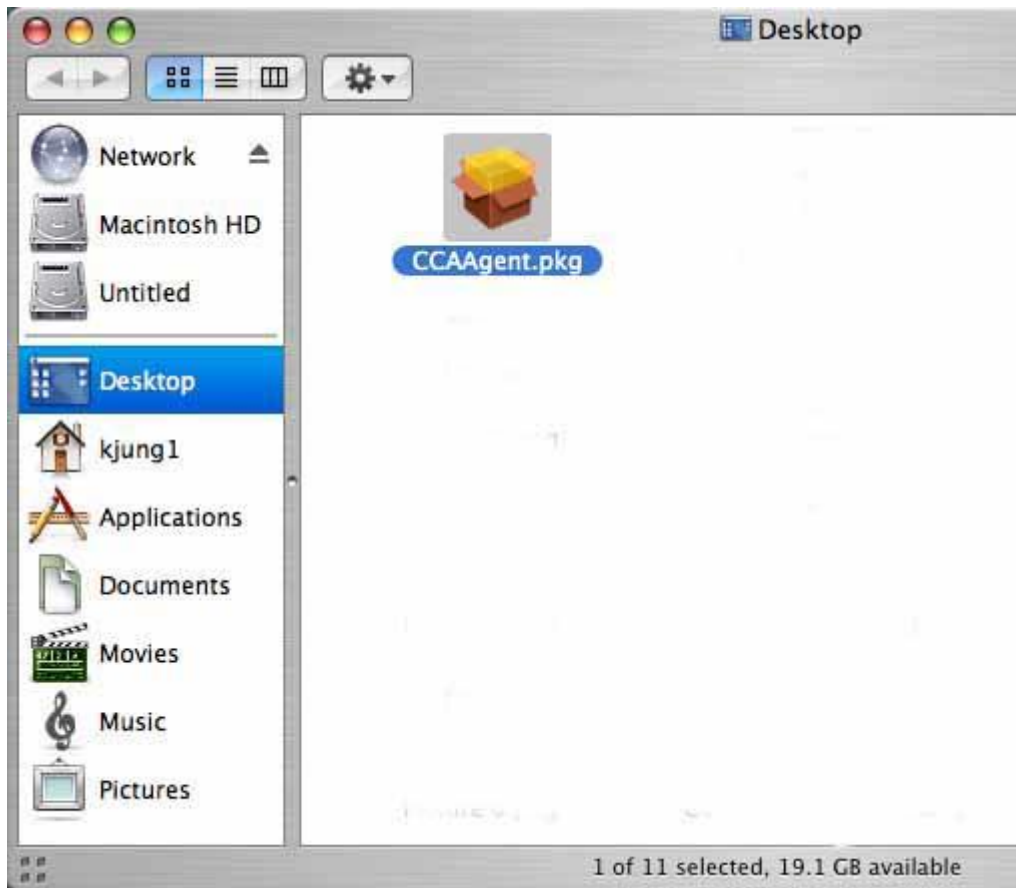
5. Click the small magnifying glass icon to the right of the "Downloads" box that will open.



Then, when the file appears in Finder, double click it to extract it.



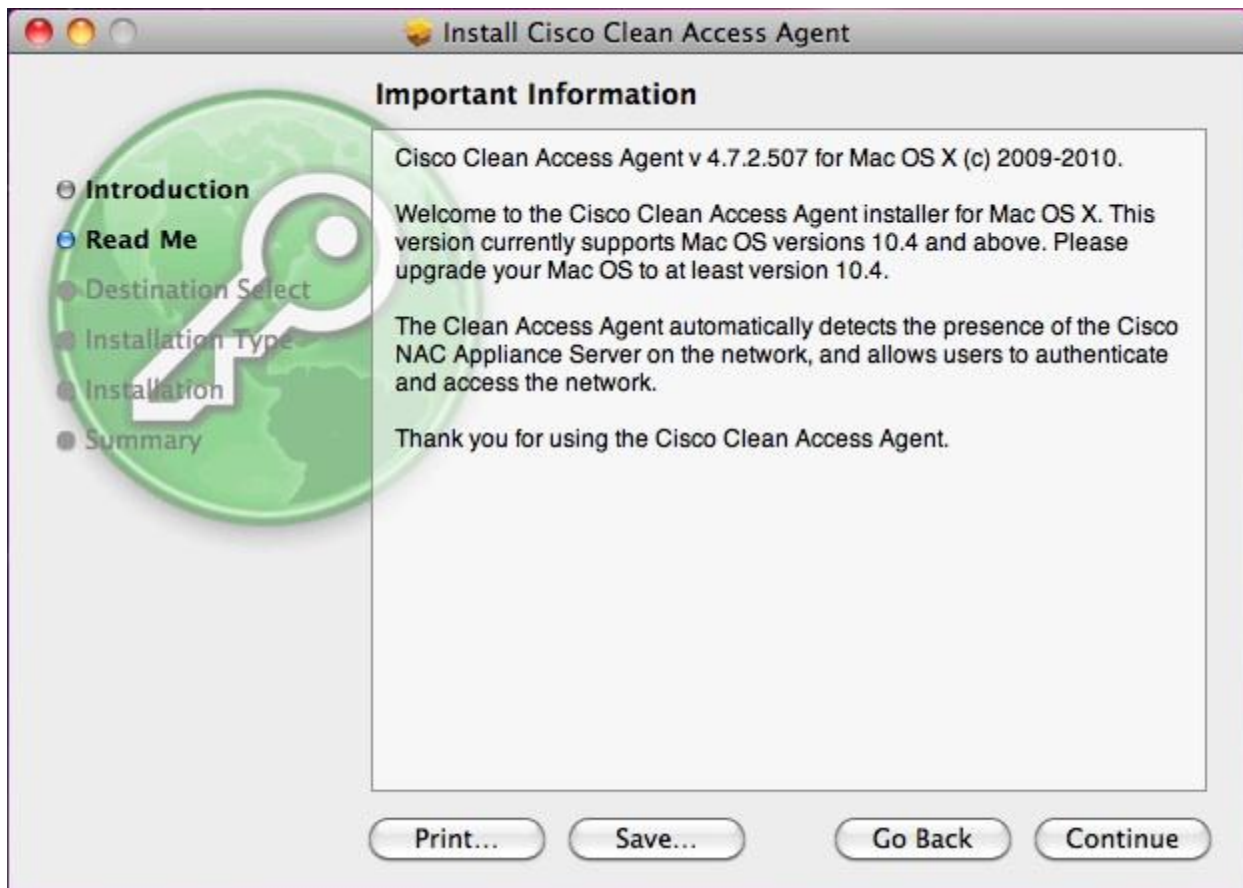
6. After the file extracts, you will see a file called "NACAgent.pkg". Double click this file to begin the installation.



7. The installer will open. Click "Continue."



8. After reading the information on the following page, click "Continue."



9. Make sure "Macintosh HD" is selected. (The green arrow will be pointing to it if it is selected.) Then click "Continue."



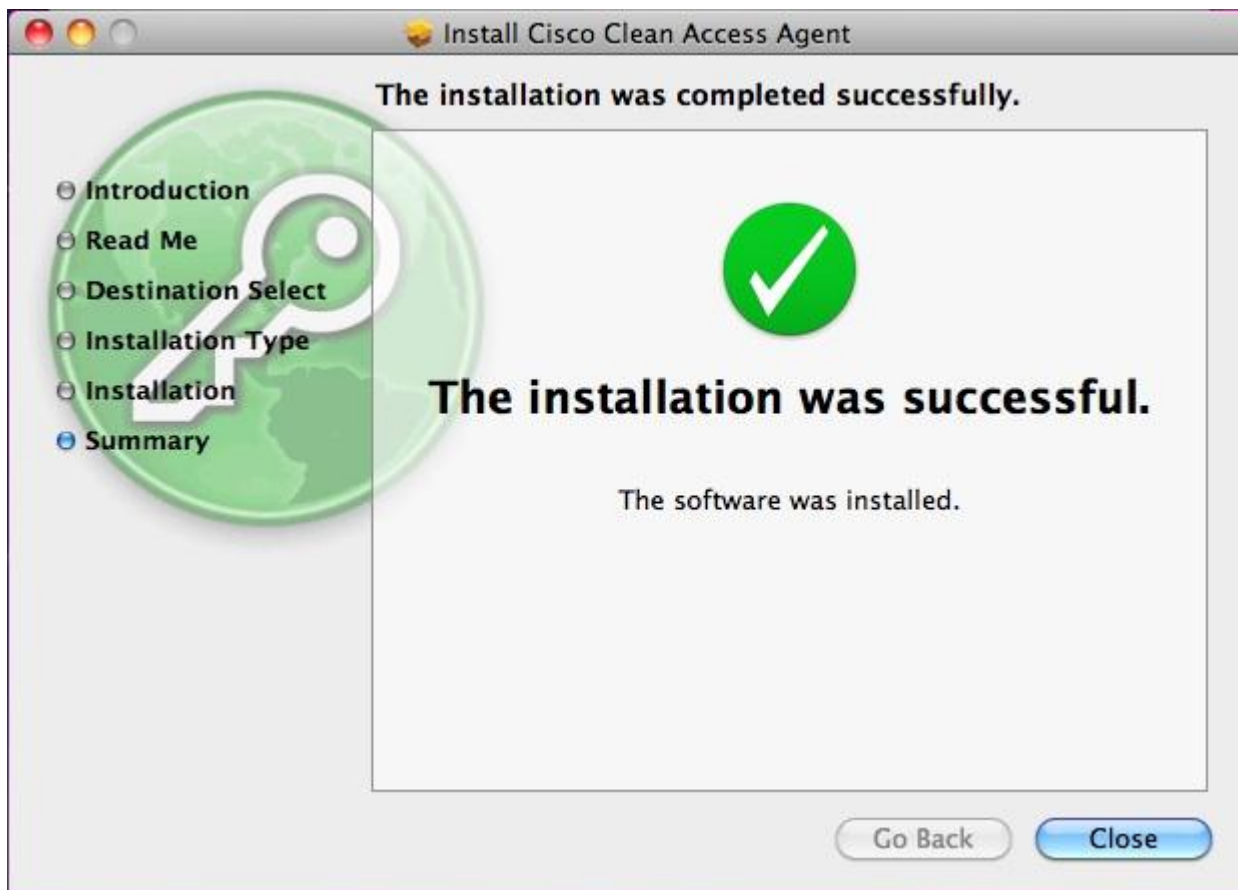
10. Click "Install"



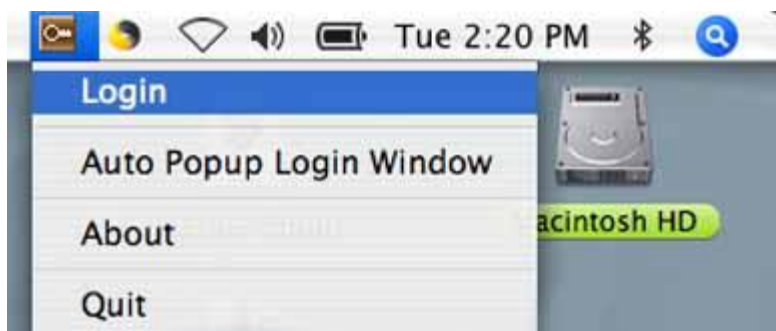
If your login is password protected, type your login name and password in the prompt. Keep in mind that this may or may not be the same as your MUNet ID and password.




11. After you see "The Software was successfully installed," click "Close."

13. Login to the Cisco NAC Agent using your MUNet ID and password. **Make sure the "Remember Me" option is checked.**
