Interpreting your GRE score

GRE scores are reported in three areas—verbal, quantitative and analytical writing.

The verbal and quantitative sections are scored on a scale of 0 to 170. The analytical writing score is reported on a scale of 0 to 6. Before adding the three sections to determine if the 370 or 396 requirements have been met, convert the analytical writing score using the following scale.

0.5 = 14	2.5 = 71	4.5 = 128
1.0 = 28	3.0 = 85	5.0 = 142
1.5 = 43	3.5 = 99	5.5 = 156
2.0 = 57	4.0 = 113	6.0 = 170
