To continue efforts to retain female faculty, MU-ADVANCE analyzed attrition rates within the STEM departments to try to identify themes or trends among those who have left. Over the last four years, 50% of STEM faculty who left the university (36 faculty in all) did so through retirement; 39% left voluntarily without retiring; and 11% were not reappointed .
