Friday, January 30, 2009



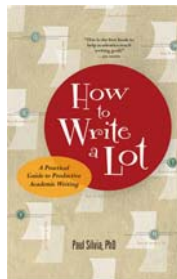

Meet the Faculty: Dr. Susan Jackman

Dr. Susan Jackman is a Professor in the Department of Biochemistry and Microbiology at the School of Medicine. Her research examines how the cells and tissues involved in immune responses communicate with each other using cytokines. Currently Dr. Jackman's lab studies an autoimmune response in mice through two projects: Immunoregulation of Skin-Directed Autoimmunity and Genetic Characterization of the Mouse Skin Genes. Her lab also studies *Streptococcus agalactiae*, group B streptococcus (GBS) the primary agent associated with life-threatening bacterial infections in the neonatal period. [More...](#)
