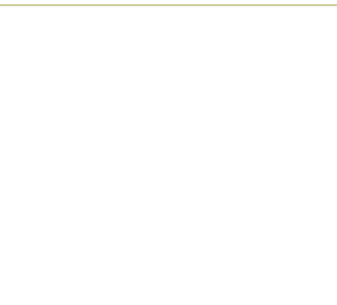
Meet the New Dean: Dr. Mary Todd
