Dr. Piyali Dasgupta, an Assistant Professor in the Department of Pharmacology, Physiology, and Toxicology, focuses her research on the effects of nicotine in regulating cellular responses in the context of lung cancer. She has been successful in garnering two awards this year to further her research efforts: a \$30K award from the Astellas Foundation and a \$300K award, with a possible two-year renewal, from the Flight Attendant Medical Research Institute.
