Saxophonist and flautist **Greg Fishman** is an accomplished performer, recording artist, author, teacher, and clinician. Greg graduated from DePaul University in Chicago with a degree in Jazz Performance, and earned a Masters Degree in Jazz Pedagogy from Northwestern University. He is among the foremost experts on the music of Stan Getz. Greg is the co-founder (w/ Paulinho Garcia) of the award-winning duo "Two For Brazil," and he has toured and performed worldwide with his group and other artists including the Woody Herman Band, Louis Bellson, Slide Hampton, Conte Candoli, Clark Terry, Don Menza, Ira Sullivan, Judy Roberts, Jimmy Heath, Lou Donaldson, Jeff Hamilton, Eddie Higgins, and Benny Golson, among others. Greg Fishman is a Rico artist and plays Rico reeds exclusively. While not on tour, he is based in the Chicago area where he performs locally and teaches at Greg Fishman Jazz Studios.
