Spring 2015 Registration Information

Advance Registration for Currently Enrolled Students begins on November 10th.

Open Registration for all Admitted Students begins November 21.

Note: Web Registration (myMU) is available 24 hours daily during designated registration periods. The following groups of students are not eligible to register online: students on academic probation, and student athletes. Registration may occur in person at the Registrar's Office in Old Main 106A Monday through Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm.

Important: Students with outstanding financial and/or academic holds will be denied registration until such holds have been resolved.

Graduation Tuition Benefit Spring, 2016

Scholarship tuition benefits are awarded based on financial need through the Graduate college.

The Graduate College will start accepting applications for the Spring 2016 benefit in mid-October. Students must have a FAFSA on file with Financial Aid to qualify.



Application Deadline for May, 2016 Graduation

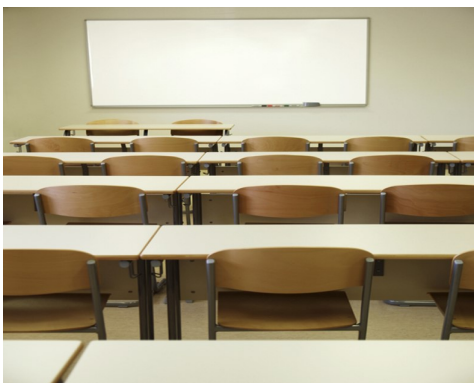
