#### **Spring 2015 Registration Information**

Advance Registration for Currently Enrolled Students begins on November 10th.

**Open Registration** for all Admitted Students begins November 21.

**Note:** Web Registration (myMU) is available 24 hours daily during designated registration periods. The following groups of students are <u>not</u> eligible to register online: students on academic probation, and student athletes. Registration may occur in person at the Registrar's Office in Old Main 106A Monday through Friday, 8:00am-5:00pm.

**Important:** Students with outstanding financial and/or academic holds will be denied registration until such holds have been resolved.

### Graduation Tuition Benefit Spring, 2016




## **Application Deadline for May, 2016 Graduation**
