A current CPR must be done every 2 years. **Only the following courses are acceptable: Documents MUST be one of the following:**

1. American Heart Association Basic Cardiac Life Support for Healthcare Providers
2. American Safety Health Institute CPR Pro for the Professional Rescuer
3. American Red Cross Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers
4. American Red Cross Adult & Pediatric CPR/AED
5. International Occupational Health Safety Association BLS for Healthcare Providers
