The **Nursing Recognition Ceremony** is pending at this time. Please check your emails for announcements on the ceremony.





Documents <u>MUST</u> be one of the following:


- 1. American Heart Association Basic Cardiac Life Support for Healthcare Providers

- The American Red Cross courses:

 A. Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers, or
 B. Adult and Pediatric CPR/AED, or
 C. Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED
- 5. American Heart Association BLS Provider
- 6. American Heart Association Heartsaver First Aid AED
- 7. The International Occupational Health and Safety Association BLS for Healthcare Provider (Inclusive of adult, child, and infant CPR and AED).
