Critical Thinking – Effective Fall 2018, both CT courses and FYS will be waived for transfer students with 60+credits and FYS and one CT course will be waived for transfer students coming in with 30-59 credits.

Only 72 hours from a community college count towards BSN.** Therefore, depending upon the number of transfer credits towards a BSN, a student may have to take additional elective hours. If your associate degree nursing program was less than 40 hours, MU SON will award up to 40 hours of credit for associate degree upon successful completion of the following classes: NUR 305, NUR 318, NUR 333, and NUR 400. It is up to each student to request additional hours of credit for an associate degree from the RN to BSN Program Director.
