CREENTIALS REQUIRED FOR EARLY COLLEGE CREDIT

Marshall University – Sophomore in High School and below

- Current enrollment in a high school program
- Completed admissions application and application fee
- An ACT / SAT at the 85th percentile or above (ACT = 26, SAT = 1180 CR+M). If the ACT or SAT has not been taken, a score at the 90th percentile or higher on another nationally-normed standardized test, such as the PLAN, that provides evidence of the ability to succeed at the college level is required.
- High School transcript reflecting a cumulative minimum GPA of 3.00
- A letter of recommendation from a counselor or principal
- A letter of recommendation from a teacher who is familiar with the student's academic performance.
- A student must maintain a 2.00 GPA in all college courses
- To take English or math courses, a student must have a qualifying ACT or SAT score in the subject area:
 - ⇒ **English courses** – an ACT English score of 18 or SAT Verbal score of 450 is required for ENG 101;
 - ⇒ **Math courses** – an ACT Math score of 19 or SAT Math score of 460 is required for MTH 123 or MTH 127; some math courses may require a higher ACT or SAT score

Marshall University – Junior or Senior year of High School

- Current enrollment in a high school program
- Completed admissions application and application fee
- High school transcript reflecting a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better
- One letter of recommendation from a counselor or principal
- To take English or math courses, a student must have a qualifying ACT or SAT score in the subject area:
 - ⇒ **English courses** – an ACT English score of 18 or SAT Verbal score of 450 is required for ENG 101;
 - ⇒ **Math courses** – an ACT Math score of 19 or SAT Math score of 460 is required for MTH 123 or MTH 127; some math courses may require a higher ACT or SAT score

Marshall University – International Junior or Senior year students taking online courses

- Current enrollment in a high school program
- Completed admissions application and application fee in USD
- High school transcript in English reflecting a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better on a 4.00 scale.
 - ⇒ A GPA from the high school transcript is acceptable if the school utilizes or can provide a conversion to an American-type grading system.
 - ⇒ If the school cannot provide a GPA in a 4.00-scale format, the student must obtain proof of a cumulative 3.00 GPA on 4.00 scale from an accepted credential evaluation agency.
- One letter of recommendation from a counselor or principal
- Proof of English proficiency. If the student is currently attending a school in which the primary language of instruction is English, the counselor or principal from that high school can certify in writing that English is the official language of instruction. For information regarding other options for proving English proficiency, please see page 34 of the Marshall University Undergraduate Catalog.
