1. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy has established an endowed fund known as the *Academic Achievement Award*
2. The income, determined by the spending policy established by The Marshall University school of Pharmacy Student Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee, shall support this annual award through the endowed fund. The fund will be managed in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) as adopted by the State of West Virginia. Additional contributions may be added at any time.
3. The Academic Achievement Award will consist of a financial award; the amount to be determined annually.
4. The recipient(s) shall be a full-time student in the Marshall University School of Pharmacy. The candidate will be evaluated based on the following criteria for the previous academic year
 - a. P2-P4 students
 - b. Successful completion of all required courses
 - c. In good academic standing
 - d. Grade Point Average (GPA)
 - e. Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) score
 - f. Pharmacy Curriculum Outcomes Assessment (PCOA) score
5. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Students Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee accepts funds where selection of recipients is not based solely on any of the following criteria unless University policy dictates otherwise: race, gender, religion, handicap or national origin.
6. Should the purpose for this fund no longer exist at Marshall University School of Pharmacy, Student Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee may designate a purpose most consistent with the original intent of the donor.
