Dean's Scholarship Award

1. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy has established an endowed fund known as the *Dean's Scholarship Award*
2. The income, determined by the spending policy established by The Marshall University Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors, shall support this annual award. The fund will be managed in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) as adopted by the State of West Virginia. Additional contributions may be added at any time.
3. The School of Pharmacy Dean's Award will consist of a financial award the amount to be determined annually.
4. Submission deadline March 1
5. The recipient(s) shall be a full-time student in the Marshall University School of Pharmacy. The candidate will be evaluated on the following criteria:
 - a. P2-P4 year
 - b. Successful completion of all required courses
 - c. Academically and professionally in good standing
 - d. Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) greater than 3.2
 - e. Involvement in community and civic organizations
 - f. Involvement in pharmacy professional organizations
 - g. Demonstration of leadership skills
 - h. Essay (500-1000 words) describing how your experiences with leadership, community / civic services and professional organizations will assist in preparing you for a career in the profession of pharmacy
6. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Students Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee accepts funds in which the selection of recipients is not to be based solely on any of the following criteria unless University policy dictates otherwise: race, gender, religion, handicap or national origin.
7. Should the purpose for this fund no longer exist at Marshall University School of Pharmacy, Student Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee may designate a purpose most consistent with the original intent of the donor.
