Don Perdue Award

1. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy has established an endowed fund known as the *Don Perdue Award*
2. The income, determined by the spending policy established by The Marshall University Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors, shall support this annual award. The fund will be managed in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) as adopted by the State of West Virginia. Additional contributions may be added at any time.
3. The Don Perdue Award will consist of a financial award the amount to be determined annually.
4. The recipient(s) shall be enrolled as a full-time student in the Marshall University School of Pharmacy. The candidate will be evaluated based on the following criteria
 - a. Matriculating P1 Student
 - b. Cumulative Grade Point Average in the top 20% of class
 - c. Composite PCAT score of 70 or greater
 - d. Marshall University School of Pharmacy total interview score
5. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Students Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee accepts funds where selection of recipients is not based solely on any of the following criteria unless University policy dictates otherwise: race, gender, religion, handicap or national origin.
6. Should the purpose for this fund no longer exist at Marshall University School of Pharmacy, Student Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee may designate a purpose most consistent with the original intent of the donor.
