***Marshall University School of Pharmacy Scholarship Award***

1. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy has established an endowed fund known as the *Marshall University School of Pharmacy Scholarship Award*
2. The income, determined by the spending policy established by The Marshall University Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors, shall support this annual award. The fund will be managed in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) as adopted by the State of West Virginia. Additional contributions may be added at any time.
3. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Scholarship will consist of a financial award the amount to be determined annually.
4. Submission deadline is March 1.
5. The recipient(s) shall be enrolled as a full-time student in the Marshall University School of Pharmacy. The candidate will be evaluated based on the following criteria
  - a. Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) equal to or greater than 2.5
  - b. If entering into the 1 year pharmacy class must have prerequisites completed by May 30.
  - c. FAFSA score
  - d. Average number of hours worked during a week (within the last six weeks)
  - e. Essay: (500 – 1000 words) From a financial standpoint, describe the impact this scholarship will have on your education and your family
5. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Students Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee accepts funds where selection of recipients is not based solely on any of the following criteria unless University policy dictates otherwise: race, gender, religion, handicap or national origin.
6. Should the purpose for this fund no longer exist at Marshall University School of Pharmacy, Student Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee may designate a purpose most consistent with the original intent of the donor.
