Stephen J Kopp Academic Excellence Award

1. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy has established an endowed fund known as the *Marshall University School of Pharmacy Stephen J Kopp Academic Excellence Award*
2. The income, determined by the spending policy established by The Marshall University Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors, shall support this annual award. The fund will be managed in a manner consistent with the provisions of the Uniform Prudent Management of Institutional Funds Act (UPMIFA) as adopted by the State of West Virginia. Additional contributions may be added at any time.
3. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Stephen J Kopp Excellence Award will consist of a financial award; the amount to be determined annually.
4. The Scholarship committee will provide recommendations to the Dean by March 1.
5. The recipient(s) shall be enrolled as a full-time student in the Marshall University School of Pharmacy. The candidate will be part of the matriculating P1 class and be evaluated based on the following criteria (minimum of 2 criteria met to be eligible)
 - a. Resident of West Virginia, Ohio, or Kentucky
 - b. Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) equal to or greater than 3.75
 - c. PCAT score greater than 85
 - d. Post interview score in the Top 10%
6. This scholarship is renewable up to 4 years provided the student maintains in good academic and professional standings.
7. The Marshall University School of Pharmacy Students Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee accepts funds where selection of recipients is not based solely on any of the following criteria unless University policy dictates otherwise: race, gender, religion, handicap or national origin.
8. Should the purpose for this fund no longer exist at Marshall University School of Pharmacy, Student Affairs, Awards and Scholarship Committee may designate a purpose most consistent with the original intent of the donor.
