**Atlantis Program Overview**

The Atlantis program provides Marshall University psychology majors with an opportunity to spend an academic year studying psychology at two European universities, one semester each at The University of Debrecen in Debrecen, Hungary, and the Warsaw School of Social Psychology in Warsaw, Poland. Courses at those schools are taught in English. Prior to travel, students will complete a course that will introduce them to the languages and cultures of Hungary and Poland. Marshall students pay tuition and fees at Marshall with no additional tuition or fees while in Europe. Additionally, Marshall students will receive a stipend of \$1,200 per month for ten months while in Europe. All courses taken in Europe will transfer to Marshall.

**Student Selection Criteria**

The program is competitive. To be considered you must meet the following criteria. **By the day of departure you must:**

1. Be a full-time Marshall student in good academic standing.
2. Have completed at least 60 cr. hrs. with a 3.0 or better overall GPA
3. Have completed at least 12 cr. hrs. of psychology coursework.
4. Have submitted this application by the application deadline and provided the accompanying documentation: (1) Official transcript of all higher education coursework completed; (2) Two letters of recommendation from psychology faculty members who are familiar with your academic performance.
5. You must have a valid passport prior to travel to Europe, but you need not have a passport in order to be considered for the Atlantis Program.
