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MU20STFE Answers to Vendor Questions

1 Are you accepting meetings to tour the area?

Answer: No in the preliminary submissions.

2 For clarification, it is our understanding that the type of "recreational trail" you are referring to in the RFP is an on-road touring route meant for cars to traverse to and from each of the breweries and not a typical trail or shared-use path used only by non-motorized users (bikers, walkers, in-line skaters, etc.).

Answer: Yes, the trail is covering a multi-county area and is meant to be an attractor for gastrotourists, craft beverage aficionados, etc. It will be similar in scope to attractions such as the "Bourbon Trail" in Kentucky.

3 If the RFP only refers to an on-road for cars, perhaps a traditional trail could also be considered to create robust motorized and non-motorized access to the emerging brewery opportunities in the area.

Answer: At would be difficult for a non-motorized trail to cover the areas discussed which are spread throughout a five-county region in the central and western parts of West Virginia. We were meaning a driving trail that could connect hospitality, recreation, dining, and craft beverage operations into an overall tourism trail.
