II. DANTES DSST Examinations Accepted

All listed DSST exams require a passing score of **400** and award **3 semester hours** of credit.

Upper Division Credits (marked as 3U)

The following exams provide upper-division credit:

- History of the Soviet Union
- Money and Banking

General DSST Subjects

- **History & Humanities:** History of the Vietnam War, Art of the Western World, Intro to World Religion, The Civil War and Reconstruction.

- **Business & Math:** Business Ethics and Society, Business Mathematics, Human Resource Management, Introduction to Business, Management Information System, Money and Banking, Organizational Behavior, Personal Finance, Principles of Finance, Principles of Supervision.
- **Science & Technology:** Astronomy, Computing and Information Technology, Environmental Science, Ethics in Technology, Fundamentals of Cybersecurity, Introduction of Geology.
- **Social Science:** Criminal Justice, Foundations of Education, Fundamentals of Counseling, General Anthropology, Health and Human Development, Introduction to Geography, Lifespan Development Psychology, Principles of Public Speaking, Principles of Statistics, Substance Abuse.
- **Writing:** Principles of Advanced English Composition, Technical Writing.

Note on Mathematics: For Business Math, Fundamentals of College Algebra, Math for Liberal Arts, Principles of Finance, and Principles of Statistics, the use of a non-programmable calculator is permitted.
