

Marshall University Regents B.A. (RBA) General Education Requirements

Total Requirement: 36 Semester Hours

Note: Marshall University courses or equivalent are accepted. Transfer courses are evaluated individually.

I. Communications (6 Hours)

- **Core Requirement:** For students starting in Fall 2025, **ENG 201** (with a grade of C or better) is required.
- **Prerequisite:** ENG 201 requires ENG 101 or 101P.
- **English (ENG) Options:** 101, 101P, 102, 201 (online), 201H, or 302.
- **Communication Studies (CMM) Options:** 103, 104H, 207, or 213 (online).

II. Humanities (6 Hours)

- **Art (ART):** 112 (online), Art History (201, 202), or ART 481/482 (WVROCKS).
- **Classical Studies (CL):** Any course except CL 200.
- **Communication Studies (CMM):** 205, 239, 240, 310, 311, 316, 320, 402, 404, 409, or 441 (rhetoric, performance, or film focus).
- **English (ENG):** Literature courses (various online options including 200, 205, 206, 214, etc.).
- **Modern or Classical Languages:** All courses (Spanish, German, Japanese available online).
- **Music (MUS):** 142, 210, 200, 250, 290, 360, 361, or 480 (WVROCKS).
- **Philosophy (PHL):** Any course except 304.
- **Religious Studies (RST):** Any courses.
- **Theatre (THE):** 112 (online) or Theatre History (440, 441).
- **Interdisciplinary/Ethics/Film:** CJ 400, ITL 483, NRRM 330, STHM 401, JMC 440, PSY 425, and PSC 480 (WVROCKS).

III. Natural or Physical Sciences (3–6 Hours)

- **Biology/Chemistry/Physics:** All BSC, CHM, and PHY courses.
- **Geography (GEO):** 101, 230, 350, 422, 425, 429, 430, 434, 450, 460.
- **Geology (GLY):** Any courses.
- **Natural Resources (NRE/NRRM):** NRE 111, 120, 200, 212, 224, 241, 320, 321, 323, 425; NRRM 310, 405.

- **Additional Sciences:** CD 221, CD 229 (Anatomy); HS 201; PH 475; PS 101.

IV. Social Sciences (6 Hours)

- **Core Disciplines:** Any courses in Anthropology (ANT), Criminal Justice (CJ), Economics (ECN), History (HST), Political Science (PSC), Psychology (PSY), or Sociology (SOC).
- **Specialized Areas:** Women's Studies (WS 101) and Sport Tourism/Hospitality (STHM 218, 405, 418).
- **Communication Studies:** CMM 213, 308, 311, 315, 319, 322, 345, 411, 420.

V. Mathematical Sciences or Computer Applications (3–6 Hours)

- **Mathematics (MTH):** 121, 121B, or higher.
- **Statistics (STA):** Any courses, including PSY 223, NRRM 200, or SOC 344.
- **Computer Science/IT:** Any CS courses; CIT or CFS 200, 261, 357, 448, 454, 461.
- **Applied Software:** GEO (GIS courses 110, 423, etc.), ITL (365, 466, 481), JMC (241, 360, 462), or MIS (200, 207, 257, 340, 350).

VI. General Education Electives (9 Hours)

- Additional hours from any of the categories above to reach the 36-hour total.
