<u>Previous Minutes:</u> The minutes of the August 8, 2005 meeting of the Safety Committee were approved as printed.

<u>Decontamination of Scientific Equipment for Yard Sale:</u> Brian has taken care of this. He has done a walk through. He will do another walk through before the yard sale and if he finds an item without a sticker on it he will go to the department that donated the item.

<u>Building Representatives List:</u> Brian has taken care of this. He is waiting for response on a couple of buildings. The Science and Smith Communications that he needs to get secondary from. He has asked Pete to help him get list for student housing. Jim suggested using RD's and RA's.

<u>Safety Equipment for Physical Plant:</u> Per Brian not all area's need steel toe shoes. This will be case by case.

<u>Plans for Driver Training Module (for Post-BRIM Use):</u> Planning to offer this through December 31, 2005 and possibly through next year. If it's not offered through next year we should get enough lead time to look for other training.

<u>Key Control:</u> Terry Olson suggested re-keying buildings and getting master keys for most of the building. He suggested doing one building per year and re-keying outside doors only. A recommendation from the Safety Committee to University Administration that it consider re-keying one building per year.

Mowing with Students Present: Dale and Brian will ask supervisors do a walk through and observe that the shields are in operation the way they should be.

<u>Fire Service Contract:</u> The contract will be up soon. Terry Olson is asking are we getting the value for our money? Brian feels that we are. Inspections are done 3 times a year. During these inspections repairs on equipment or replacements for normal wear and tears are done at no additional charge.
