### The Faculty Senate

The Marshall University Faculty Senate has just completed its 14th year of existence, having been established June 1, 1987, as a result of a majority vote of the faculty. The body is composed of proportional representation of 12 units--Lewis College of Business, College of Education & Human Services; College of Fine Arts, College of Liberal Arts, College of Science, Community & Technical College, University Libraries, School of Journalism & Mass Communications; School of Medicine; College of Nursing & Health Professions, College of Information Technology & Engineering, and MUGC At-Large--with a total of 55 Senators. Senators are elected from each of these units to four-year terms.

Much of the preliminary work of the Senate is done in the 13 standing committees which report to the Senate and whose actions (with certain exceptions) are subject to final review, modification, and approval by the full Senate.
